CU continues road swing at Presbyterian
 Cumberland travels to Clinton, S.C., for the second of three straight road games, taking on Presbyterian College. The Phoenix and Blue Hose have never met on the gridiron and this marks just the second trip to the state of South Carolina since 2000, with CU dropping a 20-3 decision at Newberry College on September 19, 2009. CU also played at North Greenville three times in Tigerville, S.C., in 1996, 1998 and 2000, the only other trips to the Palmetto state.

Cumberland keeps adding to historic start
 Cumberland has started the 2017 campaign 4-0 for the first time since 2000. That team won its first five games of the season before losing its last five. It marks just the fourth time since the program was revived in 1990 that the Phoenix have begun the year 4-0, doing so in 1993, 1998 and 2000. The 1993 squad is the only team in school history to reach the NAIA playoffs, finishing the season 9-2, while the 1998 club posted a 6-5 mark.

Cumberland, Presbyterian ties start at top
 The head coaches at Cumberland and Presbyterian have a long history, with Tommy Spangler serving as a mentor for Donnie Suber for almost 30 years. Spangler was Suber's position coach at Georgia Southern and then Suber served as a graduate assistant under Spangler with the Eagles. Suber then worked for Spangler at Presbyterian from 2002-06 during Spangler's stint as head coach with the Blue Hose.

Rucker bursts onto the scene
 Redshirt sophomore Telvin Rucker served mostly as a special teams performer last season, rushing just 10 times for 38 yards in limited offensive action. Through three games in 2017 the Memphis, Tenn., native had just 17 carries for 87 yards before making a huge impact in last week's victory at Edward Waters. Rucker rushed 20 times for 140 yards and one touchdown, leading a ground attack that totaled 244 yards and three TDs. He carried four times for 35 yards on a TD drive early in the second period and then got all of the carries on a four-play, 63-yard drive, recording gains of five, 16, 11 and 31 yards, the last one for his first career touchdown. For the season he ranks second on the club with 227 yards on 37 attempts, 6.1 yards-per-carry, with one touchdown.

Huntley racks up yards in air, on ground

Redshirt junior Dezmon Huntley enjoyed perhaps his best all-around performance at Cumberland at the University of the Cumberlands three weeks ago, passing for 291 yards and rushing for 101 yards and two touchdowns. It marked a career-best in passing yards (previous best was 202 last season at Mississippi College), completing 13-of-25. He accounted for five pass plays of 35 yards or more, including three of 42-plus. Huntley rushed 15 times for 101 yards with TD runs of eight and nine yards. After a slow start, he settled down over the final three periods against Bluefield College, accounting for 212 yards of total offense and two touchdowns in the 24-17 victory. Huntley finished 12-of-27 passing for 149 yards, one TD and two interceptions and added 63 yards rushing on 15 carries with one TD. He was also 6-for-11 passing for 62 yards and one TD on third down, a trend that continued at the Cumberlands when he finished 6-for-10 for 145 yards. He accounted for 150 yards of offense and three touchdowns in one quarter of action versus Webber International and passed for 158 yards and one score and rushed for 39 yards and another TD last week at Edward Waters. Huntley leads the Phoenix with 271 rushing yards on 41 carries, 6.6 yards-per-attempt, with six TDs and has passed for 680 yards on 42-of-78 with three TDs and three interceptions. He ranks second in the Mid-South Conference in total offense (951 yards) and sixth in passing yards.

Emanuel making big plays in secondary

Junior defensive back David Emanuel posted three tackles, one pass breakup and returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown in the victory over Webber International two weeks ago. The INT return gave Cumberland a 31-0 lead less than three minutes into the second quarter. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native has two interceptions and a fumble recovery in three games this season, accounting for 3-of-6 defensive takeaways for the Phoenix this season. It marked the first interception return for a TD by a Cumberland player since November 15, 2014, versus Alderson Broaddus. Emanuel has four interceptions over the last two seasons for the Phoenix, 44 percent of the team's total over that stretch. He has 14 total tackles with three pass breakups this season.

Rushin continues to score

Redshirt sophomore quarterback Joseph Rushin is tied with teammate Dezmon Huntley for the Mid-South Conference lead in touchdowns through four games, posting six TDs, all on the ground. The McDonough, Ga., native carried six times for 35 yards with a six-yard TD run in the season opener against Bluefield College. He then posted a crazy stat line at the University of the Cumberlands, rushing eight times for four yards and four touchdowns. Rushin recorded four one-yard TD runs, three in the first half and the final one at the beginning of the fourth quarter. It marked the most rushing touchdowns in a game by a Cumberland player since Justin Snyder had five against the University of the Cumberlands on September 19, 2015. The last running back with that many rushing TDs in a contest was Lemeco Miller, who also had five versus Union College on October 6, 2012. Rushin played a little over three quarters against Webber International, carrying 20 times for 59 yards and completing 5-of-10 passes for 13 yards and one interception. Last week at Edward Waters he rushed 12 times for 69 yards and one TD and added a 22-yard pass completion. This season he has rushed 46 times for 167 yards and completed 6-of-12 passes for 35 yards.

offense per game last season, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns. This season the club currently ranks 13th with 848 total rushing yards through four games. Seniors Nick Bodden, Chandler Peeples and Jason Smith along with junior Jeff Benson have a combined 93 career starts through four games in 2017. Bodden has played in 31 games with 28 starts while Peeples has played in 31 outings with 30 starts. Smith transferred from Eastern Kentucky two years ago and has started 23 of the 25 contests the last two seasons and Benson saw action in all 11 games last year, starting nine contests, and has four starts this season as well.

QB's spreading out passes to receivers

Eight different receivers have caught passes through four games this season for Cumberland, but no receiver has more than 12 receptions. Quarterbacks Dezmon Huntley and Joseph Rushin continue to spread the wealth and hit big plays with everyone. Junior Ladarius Rodgers leads the club with 12 catches for 168 yards

with a 44-yard reception at the University of the Cumberlands. Sophomore Kendall Johnson has 10 receptions for 96 yards with a 36-yarder versus Webber International. Sophomore Lorel Morton has posted nine catches for 165 yards and two TDs, including a 43-yarder at the Cumberlands, and junior Marcus Bryson has seven receptions for 148 yards with a 42-yarder at the Cumberlands.

Defensive scores are the norm for CU

Under head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland has registered 31 defensive touchdowns in nine-plus seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. The Phoenix registered three defensive scores in 2015, with Nathan Anderson blocking a punt out of the end zone for a safety at West Alabama and Anthony Knight picking up a blocked extra point and returning it 85 yards for two points at Valdosta State. At the University of Pikeville, Anderson blocked his second punt of the season and returned it six yards for the TD. Shedrick Kirk picked up a fumble and returned it 90 yards for a TD at Faulkner University, the only defensive score in 2016. David Emanuel added to the total with a 29-yard interception return for a TD two weeks ago versus Webber International, the first INT return for a TD by a CU player since November 15, 2014, versus Alderson Broaddus. JarVis Ruff forced a fumble near the goal line and Tyler Tate fell on the ball in the end zone for a TD last week at Edward Waters. The chart to the left has a complete listing of all defensive scores under Suber.

Defense needs more turnovers

Cumberland's defense has forced six turnovers this season, a far better pace than in the previous two campaigns. The unit forced only 13 turnovers in 11 games in 2016 – seven interceptions and six fumble recoveries – and had only 12 turnovers in 2015 – six fumbles and six interceptions – after registering 27 takeaways in 2014 and between 25 and 32 takeaways every season but one from 2009-14. The lack of turnovers contributed to the defense staying on the field for long stretches of the game. The unit was on the field for 34-plus minutes on four occasions and Cumberland lost the time of possession battle in seven of the team's 11 contests in 2015. Last year the Phoenix posted a season-high three takeaways versus Campbellsville University added a pair of intercep-

tions at Kentucky Christian and East Tennessee State. The unit posted one turnover in the the season-opener versus Bluefield College, a fourth-quarter interception by David Emanuel, who also recovered a fumble on a kickoff in the fourth quarter at the University of the Cumberlands. Cody Carr fell on a fumble and Emanuel added a 29-yard interception return for a touchdown versus Webber International and the Phoenix recovered two fumbles last week at Edward Waters, one each by Tyler Tate and DeAnthony Patrick.

Offense needs to cut down on miscues

After some major struggles with turnovers to end the 2015 campaign, Cumberland's offense kept miscues to a minimum last season, committing only 11 turnovers in 11 games. The Phoenix have not been so lucky so far in 2017, committing eight turnovers – four fumbles and four interceptions. CU posted three miscues against Bluefield College and two each versus the University of the Cumberlands and Webber International. Cumberland fumbled once last week at Edward Waters. Bluefield got three points and the Cumberlands had 10 off the CU turnovers while the last two opponents have not scored after a Phoenix miscue. Last season Cumberland fumbled twice against the Univer-

sity of Pikeville and had two miscues versus Campbellsville University. CU did not commit a turnover in four outings last season. In 2015 CU took care of the ball very well in the first five games, committing just six total turnovers, but miscues over the last six contests led directly to five straight defeats. The Phoenix committed 19 turnovers during those six outings, including four at Campbellsville and five versus Bethel University. Cumberland opponents feasted on the offense's 25 miscues in 2015, turning those into 115 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 apiece from Bethel and Lindsey Wilson.

Phoenix look to continue winning ways

Cumberland has compiled a 44-32 mark over the previous seven seasons, the best seven-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013, winning seven of its final nine outings, and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks fourth in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season heading into this week's game. Chattanooga (52-36) and Carson-Newman (52-31) are tied for first and Tennessee (50-41) is third. Cumberland (47-32) is just ahead of UT Martin, Maryville College and Middle Tennessee. Travededo garners Mid-South Conference Player of the Week accolades

Cumberland's Pablo Dongarra Travededo was voted Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Special Teams Player of the Week on Au-

gust 28 after hitting three extra points and one field goal in CU's 24-17 season-opening victory over Bluefield College. The Guayaquil, Ecuador, native connected on three extra points and booted a 37-yard field goal in his Cumberland debut. The wind knocked down his last kickoff of the game and the ball bounced away from the return men, a fumble the Phoenix recovered that led to his field goal late in the third quarter, part of a 17-point period that helped CU take control of the contest and erase a 10-7 halftime deficit. Cumberland was just 2-of-7 in field goal tries last season and 3-for-13 over the last two years before Travededo's 37-yarder versus Bluefield.

Cumberland sweeps weekly MSC awards

Cumberland's Dezmon Huntley, David Emanuel and Pablo Dongarra Travededo swept the Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Player of the Week awards on September 11 after their performances in a 38-24 victory over Webber International. Huntley passed for a touchdown and ran for two TDs in less than a quarter of action, accounting for 150 yards of total offense. He tossed a 24-yard TD to Lorel Morton for the team's first touchdown of the game and rushed 13 yards for a score on the next possession. He then scampered 55 yards for a TD, pushing the CU lead to 24-0 with 3:29 left in the opening period. Emanuel posted three tackles, one pass breakup and returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown. The INT return gave CU a 31-0 lead less than three minutes into the second quarter. It was the fourth interception of Emanuel's Phoenix career. Travededo made a 22-yard field goal for CU's first points of the contest and added five extra points in the victory. He has made as many field goals (2) in three games this season as CU made in 11 contests in 2016. He remained perfect on PATs this year as well, upping his mark to 14-for-14, and recorded his first touchback of the season.

Head Coach Donnie Suber



**Fifth Season as HC/
10th Season as
Defensive Coordinator/
Defensive Backs Coach**

Donnie Suber was named head coach at Cumberland University on January 28, 2013, the fifth head coach of the program since it was revived in 1990. He begins his fifth year as head coach and 10th season in his third stint at Cumberland, serving as the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach. He has worked as an assistant or head coach at the collegiate level for the past 24 years, 13 of those at CU.

Suber has compiled a 21-23 mark over four seasons as head coach with the Phoenix, including a combined 13-9 in his first two campaigns. Cumberland rebounded from a disappointing 3-8 year in 2015 with a 5-6 mark last season that included four losses by a combined 15 points. During his tenure as head coach, CU has earned 27 First or Second Team All-Mid-South Conference honors while collecting a pair of MSC Defensive Player of the Year accolades.

In addition 78 players have been named Academic All-Mid-South and 37 have garnered Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athlete recognition.

The Phoenix continued their recent winning ways in Suber's first year at the helm of the program, winning four straight games in the middle of the year and seven of the final nine outings to finish 7-4, the club's fourth consecutive winning season. Nathan Jernigan was voted the Mid-South Conference West Division Freshman of the Year. Cumberland also led the Mid-South Conference with 28 Academic All-MSC selections and ranked No. 1 in the nation for the second straight year with 16 Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athletes.

In 2014 the Phoenix ended the year 6-5 overall, losing its last three games thanks to a slew of injuries. Six players garnered All-Mid-South Conference recognition, including defenders Grant Jones, Justus Daus-



cha and Jernigan on the First Team.

Cumberland stood 3-3 midway through the 2015 campaign after a pair of victories and two early-season defeats to NCAA Division II institutions. Injuries and a sluggish offense led to a five-game losing streak to end the year. Eight players earned All-MSC honors, including defenders Cayman Russell and Jernigan on the First Team and Dauscha on the Second Team. Jernigan was voted MSC West Co-Defensive Player of the Year and First Team Academic All-America as well.

Cumberland's defense allowed 61.1 less rushing yards per game in 2016, helping the unit improve from 59th to 22nd in rushing yards allowed per game (140.4) and give up 12.0 fewer points per game, going from 72nd to 45th nationally. The unit also posted 28 sacks, ranking 21st in the country.

CU lost 33-29 in the season opener to Lindsey Wilson and dropped a 27-26 decision on the road at D-II Mississippi College on a last-second field goal. The club was on the wrong end of a 31-28 decision at Faulkner University and lost the season finale, 23-16, at East Tennessee State.

Four Cumberland players received All-MSC accolades, including defenders Dauscha and Jernigan, with Jernigan earning his second straight MSC West Defensive Player of the Year honor.

Suber earned his bachelor's in Recreation and Hotel Management from Georgia Southern in 1990 and played on NCAA Division I-AA national championship teams as a defensive back in 1986, 1989 and 1990.

His first coaching position was at Cumberland University as the defensive backs and strength coach as a graduate assistant. Suber earned his master's from Cumberland in Organizational Behavior in 1993.

He returned to his alma mater in 1994 as the restricted earnings coach in charge of defensive backs before coming back to Cumberland for two years in 1995-96 as defensive backs coach and men's and women's golf coach. The Columbia, S.C., native then spent four seasons as the defensive coordinator, defensive backs coach and recruiting coordinator at Newberry College.

In 2001 he held the same positions at Benedict College before serving as the linebackers coach in 2002 and then the receivers coach from 2003-06 at Presbyterian College.
