PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK 9 HONOREES

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHANDLER BURKS, KENNESAW STATE, QB, R-Jr (DOUGLASVILLE, GA.)

Burks led the Kennesaw State offense with 171 total yards and four consecutive touchdowns in its 28-0 win at Presbyterian. He rushed 14 times for 78 yards and three touchdowns, and completed 5-of-11 passes for 93 yards and a score to help the Owls take a 28-0 lead into the fourth quarter. Burks' two-yard touchdown rush with 8:43 remaining in the first half gave KSU a 7-0 lead it never surrendered, followed by a 17-yard strike on the ensuing drive to make it 14-0 at halftime. He then led KSU to the end zone on its first two possessions of the second half.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JEREMY PETERS, LIBERTY, CB, Jr (GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FLA.)

Peters had three interceptions and returned one 15 yards for a touchdown in Liberty's 33-17 win at Gardner-Webb. He intercepted his first pass in the end zone to end a GWU scoring threat in the first quarter with the Flames ahead by five. Following his pick-six with 2:38 left in the game, Peters sealed the victory with his third INT at the Liberty 22-yard line. He added three pass break-ups and two stops.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TREY TURNER, LIBERTY, P, Gr (ROME, GA.)

Turner punted five times at Gardner-Webb for a 44.2 yard average and placed three inside the 20-yard line. Three of his kicks went at least 45 yards -- including a 53-yarder, and none of his punts were returned. Turner's effort gave Liberty the field possession advantage as GWU's average start after his punts was its own 15-yard line.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ERIC ZOKOURI, MONMOUTH, RB, Fr (SILVER SPRING, MD.)

Zokouri led the Hawks with 98 all-purpose yards to help Monmouth to a key 23-20 win at Charleston Southern. He opened the game's scoring with an 8-yard TD catch in the second quarter. Zokouri, who averaged 4.8 yards per carry, was the team's second-leading receiver with 69 yards on three receptions -- including a career-long 48-yard catch that set up MU with a 1st-and-Goal and eventual 16-0 lead.

MONUMENTAL

For the first time in program history, Monmouth is nationally-ranked, as the Hawks are No. 24 in this week's FCS Coaches Poll. The squad is 7-1 for the first time since opening the 2006 campaign at 10-1, and has won seven games for the first time since 2008. The Hawks have scored 30 points in six of its seven victories this season, a feat last accomplished in 2008. The conference record for most 30-point games in a season is 13 established by Coastal Carolina in 2014.

BIRDS OF A FEATHER

Preseason co-favorite Kennesaw State is 3-0 in the Big South for the first time and remains atop the league standings. Meanwhile, Monmouth is looking to start 3-0 in Big South play for the first time since joining the league in 2014. The two teams are scheduled to meet in the regular-season finale on Nov. 18.

BIG SOUTH LANDS THREE ON NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

The Big South placed three of the 17 candidates on the STATS Jerry Rice Award Watch List last week, as Kennesaw State LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG**, Monmouth RB **PETE GUERRIERO** and Presbyterian College RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** were among the initial honorees. It is the second consecutive year that the league has three candidates for the nation's top freshman in the same season.

BIG SOUTH GUARANTEED ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE SEASON

The Big South is 14-11 (=56.0 percent) against non-conference FCS opponents in 2017. The league is guaranteed its fifth consecutive winning regular-season in non-league contests with two out-of-conference games remaining. Since the start of the 2013 campaign, the Big South is 78-43 (=64.5 winning percentage) in regular-season competition and 83-49 (=62.9) when including postseason games in that span.

KENNESAW STATE SETS BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE 300-YARD RUSH GAMES

The Kennesaw State Owls have rushed for 300 yards in a Big South-record five consecutive games. KSU has rushed for 1,782 yards in that span (356.4 average), including a conference-game record 498 in Week 7 at Liberty. The Owls lead the nation in rushing yards per game with 329.4 -- the second-highest single-season average in league history.

BURKS BREAKS THROUGH

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** has scored a rushing TD in five consecutive games, tied for the third-longest streak by a quarterback in league history and two away from matching the record of seven set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2005-06. Burks notched his fourth career 3-TD rush game this past Saturday at Presbyterian, the most by a Big South quarterback in the conference record book and tied for the third-most overall in league annals.

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern has held its last three opponents to less than 100 yards rushing (62.3 average) and a league-high five times overall this season. The Bucs rank first in conference games in rushing defense (81.5) and total defense (256.0).

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **MIKE BASILE** is the Big South's all-time leader for career solo tackles with 259, as he broke the record of 243 in Week 6 with a Big South single-game record 17 solo hits at Holy Cross. Basile's 393 career total stops are fourth-most in the Big South record book, and seven away from becoming just the fourth Big South player with 400 career tackles. Meanwhile, Basile is tied for second in league history with five career blocked kicks. The all-time record is nine, which is held by Presbyterian College's and three-time NFL Pro Bowler **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

ELLIS ISLAND

Charleston Southern DL, Buck Buchanan Award candidate and Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **ANTHONY ELLIS** is just the third player in Big South history with 40 career tackles-for-loss and 20 career sacks. He is tied for second with 20.5 career sacks and is fourth with 42.5 career TFL and joined Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (53.5 TFL, 20.5 SK) and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** (44.0 TFL, 25.0 SK) in this exclusive club in Week 7. Ellis is second in the Big South this season with 5.5 sacks, and is 1.5 away from joining Uzowihe as the only players in league annals with three 7.0 sack seasons.

WHITEBOARD

Monmouth R-junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** caught 10 passes for 187 yards and two scores in Week 8 vs. Liberty. It was his fifth career 10-reception game, the second-most in Big South history. The career record is eight, held by Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE**.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State and Monmouth rank 11th and 12th, respectively, in the nation in rushing defense. The Owls are permitting 86.1 rushing yards per game and have held four foes to less than 100 yards on the ground. The Hawks have allowed an average of 94.8 rushing yards per game. The Big South single-season record for rushing defense is 101.0 yards per game set by Stony Brook in 2011.

HIGH FIVE

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** is the first Big South quarterback in league history with two 5-TD pass games in the same season. He has tied the conference single-game record twice this year -- first in Week 2 and again in Week 8 with five scoring strikes at Monmouth. Calvert, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, now shares the career record of most 5-TD pass games (2) with former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**.

BUCS OWN RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH ROAD WINS

Charleston Southern opened Big South play with a 7-0 win at Presbyterian in Week 7 for its eighth consecutive Big South road win, setting the conference record. The old mark of seven was first accomplished by Liberty from Nov. 18, 2006 to Nov. 14, 2009. CSU's current streak began Nov. 1, 2014, and the Bucs put the streak on the line this Saturday at Gardner-Webb.

STRETCH ARMSTRONG

Kennesaw State R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** continues to lead the Big South with 6.0 sacks -- just one away from tying the league's freshman record of 7.0 set by Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** in 2010 and tied by Charleston Southern LB **SOLOMON BROWN** in 2015. Armstrong, who has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and three-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1, 2 & 6), also ranks among the Big South leaders in fumble recoveries (1st), tackles per game (4th), TFL (10th), interceptions (T-3rd) and passes defended (T-6th).

IF THE SCHU FITS

Gardner-Webb senior kicker **PAUL SCHUMACHER** became the ninth kicker in Big South history with 30 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 7 at N.C. Central. Schumacher, who is the third GWU kicker on the league's all-time list, sits at 32 and needs two to move into a tie for eighth-place.

RUSH WEEK

Monmouth freshman running back tandem **ERIC ZOKOURI** and **PETE GUERRIERO** combined for 355 rushing yards against Liberty in Week 8. Zokouri gained a team-high 193 yards with two TDs on 18 carries, while Guerriero tallied 162 and a score on 18 attempts. It was the fourth-highest combined rushing total in a Big South game and the seventh-highest overall total. Zokouri and Guerriero are the first Big South teammates to each rush for more than 150 yards in the same game since Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (182) and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (174) against Charleston Southern on Nov. 5, 2011.

BIG BIRDS

Monmouth racked up 608 yards of offense in Week 8 against Liberty, the ninth-highest total in a Big South game in league history. The Hawks and Flames combined for 95 points, the fourth-highest in a conference match-up, while the combined 1,137 offensive yards were also the fourth-most in a league affair.

HOMeward BOUND

Presbyterian College concluded its Big South-record **SEVEN-GAME** homestand this past Saturday with a 3-4 record. The Blue Hose will host eight games at Bailey Memorial Stadium this season after the Week 2 PC at The Citadel game was moved to Clinton due to Hurricane Irma. The Big South's previous longest homestand was four games, which occurred six times and most recently by Gardner-Webb in 2016.

ALLS WELLS THAT ENDS WELLS

Liberty junior DL **JUWAN WELLS** has posted a TFL in six of eight games this season and in 19 of his 29 career appearances (=65.5 percent). He has 25.5 TFLs in his career with 13.0 sacks. Wells ranks first among all Big South defensive linemen with 7.4 tackles per game (sixth overall) and has led the Flames in tackles four times this season.

ESPN3 is carrying a Big South game each week the remainder of the season, including a "Wildcard" selection the final week of the regular-season. Coverage of that game will be determined later this week.

BIG SOUTH COVERAGE ON STADIUM NETWORK CONCLUDES NOV. 11

Big South football on the new Stadium Network concludes Saturday, Nov. 11 with the Gardner-Webb at Monmouth contest live at 12:00pm. **MATT HARMON** (play-by-play) and **TODDERICK HUNT** (analyst) have the call from Kessler Stadium. The Big South will appear on Stadium three times this season.

BIG SOUTH DEBUTS ON "COLLEGE FOOTBALL DOWN SOUTH"

A new partnership this season with **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP** features four Big South football broadcasts on a new regional network of broadcast TV stations called "*College Football Down South*." The next broadcast is Saturday's Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb contest. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **HAROLD NICHOLS** (analyst) have the call from Boiling Springs. The next broadcast is the Nov. 11 Presbyterian at Liberty game.

TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 television slate features 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3**, **STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**.

CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** leads the Big South with 2,586 passing yards and 23 TDs. His 323.2 passing yards per game is pacing way ahead of the league record of 274.7 (Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006), and is on track for 3,556 yards, which is ahead of the Big South single-season record of 3,389. Calvert could also become the first QB in conference annals to throw 30 touchdown passes in a season, as he is seven away with three games to play. He has tossed a TD pass in 10 consecutive games dating back to last season -- the sixth-longest streak in Big South history. Meanwhile, Calvert has two 400-yard passing games to his credit this year -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat in a campaign.

TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** is second in the Big South with nine rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist has carried the ball a total of 37 times for 170 yards -- with a long of 42 -- and has scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1, 3, 4, 4 and 1 yards for the Hawks. Jones is just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3. He was the third player in Kennesaw State's young history to reach the benchmark, and is now the program's all-time leader with 1,403 -- ahead of former teammates **CHASTON BENNETT** (1,321) and **TREY WHITE** (1,059). RBs **DARNELL HOLLAND** (1,115) and **JAKE MCKENZIE** (1,214) surpassed the milestone in Week 7 at Liberty to give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards.

TORRANCE THE TERRIFIC

Presbyterian College freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** is the first Big South freshman ever to score a touchdown in five consecutive games, as he tallied a team-leading five (three rushing, two receiving) during Weeks 2-6. Marable is second in the Big South with 624 rushing yards -- just 49 yards off the lead -- and is looking to become the first Blue Hose player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing.

KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** has caught 54 passes for 559 yards through eight games. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King already has two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 141. Monmouth holds the second-longest active streak at 33 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 30 games.

RANK AND FILE

The Big South returned to the national rankings this week following a four-week hiatus, and re-enters the Top 25 with two programs in the FCS Coaches poll -- Monmouth at No. 24 and Kennesaw State at No. 25. It is the third time this season two Big South teams were nationally-ranked in the same week, and the 41st time overall in Big South history. Kennesaw State is at No. 25 in the STATS FCS poll, while the Hawks are in the 28th position of that ranking. The Big South's streak of 83 consecutive weeks with a nationally-ranked football member ended Oct. 2 entering Week 6, which marked the first time the Big South was outside the two major Top 25 polls since Week 8 of the 2011 season (Oct. 17).

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has posted back-to-back seasons with 50+ receptions, and has career totals of 160 catches for 2,071 receiving yards with 18 TDs. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White became the 14th Big South player with 2,000 career receiving yards this past Saturday. In addition, he needs two catches to enter the league's all-time Top 10, as well as two TDs to become the 10th player with 20.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's active career rushing leader with 2,687 -- the only signal-caller in conference annals above the 2,000-yard threshold. That effort is good for seventh all-time in league history and 174 away from moving into sixth-place. He needs 313 rushing yards to become just the sixth player with 3,000 in a career. Maxwell led the Big South in rushing in 2016 with 965 yards -- the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher -- and is currently tops this year with 673.

BANK ON BURKS

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** is the second Big South quarterback with 10 rushing touchdowns in a season, as he currently leads the league with 10. The conference single-season record for TD rushes by a signal-caller is 12, set by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. Burks is tied for second all-time among quarterbacks in Big South history with 19 career rushing scores, and one away from joining Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** as the only QBs with 20. Meanwhile, Burks ranks fifth on the Big South's quarterback career rushing list with 1,403 yards, and needs 162 to move into fifth-place.

GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** has caught 51 passes for a league-best 888 yards and eight TDs in eight games this season. In 11 games as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden has five 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 111.0 receiving yards per game is ahead of Summers' league record of 108.1. Gandy-Golden is on pace for 1,221 receiving yards, which would be the third-highest single-season total in Big South annals.

50-50 RAFFLES

Liberty receiving tandem **DAMIAN KING** (54) and **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** (51) are the first pair of Big South teammates with 50 receptions in the same season since 2014 and the seventh overall. It is the third time Liberty has achieved this accomplishment, the most by any school. In Week 1 at Baylor, King and Gandy-Golden became the first Big South teammates ever with at least 10 catches in the same game. Gandy-Golden posted career-highs of 13 receptions for 192 yards against the Bears, while King caught 10 balls for 66 yards.

KENYATTA WILL GET-YA

Gardner-Webb senior LB **KENYATTA DUNBAR** leads the Big South with 1.6 TFL per game and 12.5 total tackles-for-loss -- the only Big South player in double-digits. He posted a TFL in five consecutive games -- including three straight with at least 3.0 TFL during Weeks 2-4 (10.0 total) to be the first Big South player to record three-straight 3.0+ TFL games since Gardner-Webb All-American DL **HAROLD WELLS** in 2004. Wells posted 10.5 tackles-for-loss during his streak (4.5, 3.0, 3.0). Dunbar entered the season with just 1.5 career stops behind the line.

BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior LB **SOLOMON BROWN** has tied the Big South record for most quarterback sacks by a linebacker, as he now has 14.0 in his career to match the record first set by Coastal Carolina's **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (2003-05). Brown became the 18th member of the league's 30.0 TFL club in Week 8, and sits at 33.0 through 30 career appearances.

KAMERON KAN

Charleston Southern R-sophomore WR **KAMERON BROWN** connected with R-sophomore QB **SHANE BUCENELL** on an 87-yard touchdown pass against Mississippi Valley State in Week 5, tied for the fourth-longest pass play in Big South history. In 18 career games, Brown has caught 46 career passes for 973 yards -- a 21.15 career yards per catch average -- and eight scores.

ROMAN EMPIRE

Kennesaw State R-senior **DB KEON ROMAN** became just the second player in Big South history with at least two interceptions in back-to-back games when he picked off two passes in Week 5 against North Greenville after collecting two INTs in the team's previous outing at Alabama State in Week 3. Roman joined former Charleston Southern DB **CHARLES JAMES** as the only Big South players to achieve this feat. James' two consecutive multi-INT games occurred in 2010 (five total).

MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB, Walter Payton Award candidate and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the first Big South QB in league history with 20 career rushing touchdowns and 20 career passing TDs. He broke the quarterback record of 19 rushing TDs with two scores at N.C. Central in Week 7 to give him 20. Maxwell has thrown 22 career scoring strikes.

COVER 2

Monmouth R-senior DB **TEDDIE MARTINEZ** leads the Big South with five interceptions, and posted his second multi-interception game this season with two picks at Bucknell in Week 5. He now has nine career interceptions during his time in the Big South and is one pick shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career INTs.

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** posted his 10th career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing in Week 7 at N.C. Central to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 165 yards on the ground and 138 through the air against the Eagles. It was Maxwell's 11th career 100-yard rushing game -- the eighth-most by any Big South player.

THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE

Charleston Southern senior DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** forced his third fumble of the season in Week 7 at Presbyterian. He has forced seven fumbles in his career, tied for the third-most in Big South history. That record is nine, set by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**.

DUMAS DOES MORE

Monmouth DB **KAMAU DUMAS** returned a punt 89 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 at Holy Cross -- the second-longest punt return in Big South history. He later intercepted a pass and returned it 39 yards for a score to become the just the second player in the conference record book with a punt return TD and pick-six in the same game. Presbyterian College's **JUSTIN BETHEL** was the first in 2011, when he returned a blocked punt and interception for scores at California on Sept. 17.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, KENNESAW STATE TIE FOR TOP PRESEASON SPOT

For the first time, two teams finished as the favorite in the annual Big South preseason football poll, as two-time defending conference champion Charleston Southern University and third-year program Kennesaw State University claimed the top spot in the 2017 preseason rankings as voted by the league's head coaches and media panel. Both teams received nine first-place votes, eight second-place votes and one third-place vote to finish atop the poll with 80 points each. The Owls will host the Buccaneers on Saturday, Nov. 11.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

CALVERT GETS BIG SOUTH PASSING RECORD TRIFECTA IN BAYLOR WIN

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** set three Big South single-game passing records during the Flames' Week 1 win at Baylor. He established new marks for completions (44), attempts (60) and yardage (447) against the Bears. Calvert's effort bested the previous records of 37 completions (Presbyterian's **TIM WEBB** at Wofford in 2008), 57 attempts (Webb at Appalachian State in 2008) and 430 yards (Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** at VMI in 2014). Calvert's 447 yards of offense at Baylor is the fourth-most in a game in Big South history.

* Charleston Southern fell to Monmouth for the first time in the series with the loss to the Hawks on Saturday night. The defeat ended the Bucs' two-year conference home opener winning streak.

* The Monmouth game was just the third time this season an opponent eclipsed 200 passing yards against the CSU defense.

* RB **NOAH SHULER** carried the ball a career-high 19 times for 77 yards and a TD to pace the CSU rushing efforts for the fourth time this year.
