PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK 11 HONOREES

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - STEPHEN CALVERT, LIBERTY, QB, SOPH (PLANTATION, FLA.)

Calvert passed for 311 yards and three touchdowns in directing the Flames' to 628 yards of offense in their 47-28 win over Presbyterian. All three of his TD strikes were in the first half and at least 30 yards in distance. Calvert finished the day with zero interceptions and a 192.40 passing efficiency.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ANTHONY GORE JR., KENNESAW STATE, LB, R-Jr (STATESBORO, GA.)

Gore posted a team-high eight tackles (seven solo) with two sacks for loss of 15 yards in the Owls' 38-0 win over Charleston Southern. He helped limit the Bucs to 187 yards of offense, and his second sack of the day was on 3rd down that pushed CSU back into its own territory.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FRANKIE HICKSON, LIBERTY, KR, R-SOPH (LYNCHBURG, VA.)

Hickson opened the PC game with an 84-yard kickoff return that set-up Liberty's first score two plays later to give the Flames control of the contest. He averaged 29.5 yards on his kickoff returns and finished the day with 215 all-purpose yards.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - BRYSON ARMSTRONG, KENNESAW STATE, LB, R-Fr (MARIETTA, GA.)

Armstrong was a key contributor in Kennesaw State's shutout victory over Charleston Southern, as he recorded four stops (three solo), two sacks for minus-16 yards, forced a fumble and broke-up a pass. His first quarter sack-fumble on 3rd down was recovered by KSU that led to the Owls' second touchdown.

NOV. 18 IS BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP SATURDAY

This Saturday's season-finale between 4-0 Kennesaw State and 4-0 Monmouth on ESPN3 will decide the Big South's automatic qualifier to the FCS Playoffs. It will be the league's second-ever "Winner Take All" Championship game regular-season finale, as the first was in 2011 (Stony Brook-Liberty). It will be the first Big South title for either program, as well as the league's ninth undefeated and outright champion in 16 years of Big South football.

BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP GAME FEATURES MATCH-UP OF RANKED MEMBERS

As noted above, No. 21/22 Kennesaw State hosts No. 22 Monmouth on Saturday for the 2017 Big South Football Championship and auto bid to the FCS postseason. It will mark the third straight season and fifth time in league history that two Big South teams ranked in the two major FCS polls will go head-to-head. The previous times were 2013, 2015 and twice in 2016. Kennesaw State was involved in the most recent match-up in 2016 against Charleston Southern. Meanwhile, the game is ESPN3's Wildcard selection, with **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JAY SONNHALTER** (analyst) on the 2:00pm call from Fifth Third Bank Stadium.

WAS THAT A NINER I JUST HEARD?

For the third time in five seasons and fourth time overall, two Big South football members have won nine regular-season games in the same year, as Kennesaw State and Monmouth each have nine victories in 2017. KSU's nine wins are a school record, while Monmouth has reached the 9-win plateau for the first time since 2006 and the fourth time overall.

PRIME NINE

Kennesaw State has won a program-record nine consecutive games, which is tied for the second-longest single-season win streak in Big South history. It is also the fourth-longest overall win streak in league annals. The last member to win at least nine games in succession was Coastal Carolina in 2014 when the Chanticleers won 11-straight during the campaign.

OWL BE WATCHING

Kennesaw State is the first Big South member in history to hold three consecutive conference opponents to **three points-or-less**, as the Owls have permitted just a field goal in their past three league contests. KSU is also the second team with back-to-back shutouts in Big South games, joining the 2008 Liberty Flames. Meanwhile, Kennesaw State has held its last four opponents to less than 300 yards of offense and an average of just 239.5 in that span. The Big South record is five games, first set by Liberty in 2013 and matched by Charleston Southern in 2015. The Owls lead the Big South in total defense at 273.9, which is pacing ahead of the single-season league record of 292.0 set by Charleston Southern in 2015.

MONUMENTAL

Monmouth is nationally-ranked for the first time in program history, as the Hawks debuted at No. 24 in the FCS Coaches Poll on Oct. 30 and is No. 22 in the FCS Coaches poll this week. The squad is 9-1 for the first time since opening the 2006 campaign at 10-1, and has scored 30 points in eight of its nine victories this season -- a program record. The conference record for most 30-point games in a season is 13 established by Coastal Carolina in 2014.

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **MIKE BASILE** became just the fourth Big South player in history with 400 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 10. He is third all-time in league annals with 412 stops, and 29 away from second-place. Basile, who is the Big South's all-time leader for career solo tackles with 274, is just the third player with three 100-tackle seasons, and is four solo stops shy of the Big South single-season record of 85. Meanwhile, Basile is second in league history with six career blocked kicks. The all-time record is nine, which is held by Presbyterian College's and three-time NFL Pro Bowler **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

KENNESAW STATE EXTENDS BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE 300-YARD RUSH GAMES

The Kennesaw State Owls have rushed for 300 yards in a Big South-record seven consecutive games. KSU has rushed for 2,128 yards in that span (353.0 average), including a conference-game record 498 in Week 7 at Liberty. The Owls lead the nation in rushing yards per game with 332.4 -- the second-highest single-season average in league history.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State and Monmouth rank 12th and 16th, respectively, in the nation in rushing defense. The Owls are permitting 96.0 rushing yards per game and have held four foes to less than 100 yards on the ground. The Hawks have allowed an average of 103.6 rushing yards per game. The Big South single-season record for rushing defense is 101.0 yards per game set by Stony Brook in 2011.

BIG SOUTH SCORES ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE SEASON

The Big South is one of two conferences (Southland) with two 1-loss teams, and is 16-11 (=59.3 percent) against non-conference FCS opponents in 2017, marking the league's fifth consecutive winning regular-season against non-league foes. Since the start of the 2013 campaign, the Big South is 80-43 (=65.0 winning percentage) in regular-season competition and 85-49 (=63.4) when including postseason games in that span.

BIG SOUTH LANDS THREE ON NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

The Big South has three of the 17 candidates on the STATS Jerry Rice Award Watch List, as Kennesaw State LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG**, Monmouth RB **PETE GUERRIERO** and Presbyterian College RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** were among the initial honorees. It is the second consecutive year that the league has three candidates for the nation's top freshman in the same season.

HOUSE CALLS

Monmouth finished its home schedule a perfect 5-0, the first Big South member to complete the regular-season undefeated at home since 2015. Kennesaw State is also 5-0 at home this season, and needs to defeat the Hawks this Saturday to remain unscathed at Fifth Third Bank Stadium. Should KSU manage the victory, it would be the second time in three years that two Big South squads went undefeated at home in regular-season games. The last time two members finished unbeaten overall at home was in 2009.

BURKS ADDED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** was added to the STATS Walter Payton Award Watch List last week as a candidate for the FCS National Offensive Player of the Year. Burks' six-game TD rush streak ended this past Saturday and goes down as the second-longest by a quarterback in league history. During that span, he notched his fourth career 3-TD rush game in Week 9 at Presbyterian, the most by a Big South quarterback in the conference record book and tied for the third-most overall in league annals.

STRETCH ARMSTRONG

Kennesaw State R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** leads the Big South with a league-freshman record 9.0 quarterback sacks. He broke the previous freshman mark of 7.0 first set by Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** in 2010 and equalled by Charleston Southern LB **SOLOMON BROWN** in 2015. Armstrong needs a half-sack to tie the Big South single-season record of 9.5 set by Liberty's **TOBY ONYECHI** in 2014. Meanwhile, Armstrong -- who has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and three-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1, 2 & 6) -- ranks among the Big South leaders in fumble recoveries (1st), tackles per game (T-4th), TFL (T-5th), interceptions (T-4th) and passes defended (T-6th).

ELLIS TACKLES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR TFL, HAS EYE ON LEAGUE'S CAREER SACK TOTAL

Charleston Southern DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** recorded a Big South single-game record 5.5 tackles-for-loss in Week 10 at Gardner-Webb. He bested the old mark of 5.0, which was accomplished seven times and last by Kennesaw State's **TONARIUS PORTRESS** in 2016. Ellis' 5.5 TFL included 2.5 sacks, which pushed his season total to 8.0, making him just the second Big South player with three 7.0-sack seasons. He has 23.0 career quarterback sacks to rank second all-time in Big South history and just two away from tying the career mark of 25.0 held by Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE**.

BUCS' RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH ROAD WINS ENDS AT NINE

Charleston Southern's Big South-record for consecutive league road wins ended at nine this past Saturday at Kennesaw State, as the Owls blanked the Buccaneers, 38-0. The loss also ended CSU's scoring streak in Big South games at 50, as the squad was held scoreless in a conference game for the first time since Nov. 1, 2008. The Bucs began their record road win streak on Nov. 1, 2014 and surpassed the old league mark of seven in their Big South opener in Week 7 with a 7-0 win at Presbyterian.

ELLIS ISLAND

With 23.0 career sacks and 49.5 career TFL, Charleston Southern DL, Buck Buchanan Award candidate and Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **ANTHONY ELLIS** is on the verge of becoming the Big South's first-ever 25/50 player. He is second all-time in both categories, trailing just Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** on the TFL chart (53.5) and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** on the sack list (25.0). Ellis can join Johnston as the only players with 20.0 sacks and 50.0 TFL.

WHITEBOARD

Monmouth R-junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** caught 10 passes for 187 yards and two scores in Week 8 vs. Liberty. It was his fifth career 10-reception game, the second-most in Big South history. The career record is eight, held by Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE**.

BIG SOUTH COVERAGE ON "COLLEGE FOOTBALL DOWN SOUTH" CONCLUDES SATURDAY

A new partnership this season with **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP** features four Big South football broadcasts on a new regional network of broadcast TV stations called "*College Football Down South*." The final broadcast of the season is Saturday's Liberty at Charleston Southern contest. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **WILL MERRITT** (analyst) have the call from CSU Stadium.

TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 television slate featured 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3, STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**. ESPN3's coverage was an exclusive seven-game package, including a Wildcard selection for the regular-season finale. Stadium televised three games.

TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** is tied for the Big South lead with 11 rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist has carried the ball a total of 54 times for 279 yards -- with long runs of 42 and 53 -- and has scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1, 3, 4, 4, 1, 2 and 1 yards for the Hawks. Jones, who is just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season, is the first Monmouth player to score 10 rushing touchdowns since MU joined the Big South in 2014, and is the second player in league history with at least 10 rushing TDs and less than 100 carries. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** rushed for 12 scores in 2005 on 68 attempts.

IF THE SCHU FITS

Gardner-Webb senior kicker **PAUL SCHUMACHER** became the ninth kicker in Big South history with 30 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 7 at N.C. Central. Schumacher, who is the third GWU kicker on the league's all-time list, is now tied for seventh-place with 35, and needs five to become the sixth Big South kicker with 40.

CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** is the third different quarterback in Big South history with 3,000 passing yards in a season, as he is tops in the conference with 3,108. He needs 282 in the season finale to break the Big South single-season record of 3,389. Calvert's 27 passing TDs are second-most in a campaign, and three away from becoming the first QB in conference annals to throw 30 touchdown passes in a season. Calvert, whose 310.8 passing yards per game is pacing way ahead of the league record of 274.7 (Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006), has tossed a TD pass in 12 consecutive games dating back to last season -- tied for the fourth-longest streak in Big South history. Meanwhile, Calvert has two 400-yard passing games to his credit this year -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat in a campaign.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3. He was the third player in Kennesaw State's young history to reach the benchmark, and is now the program's all-time leader with 1,578 -- ahead of former teammates **CHASTON BENNETT** (1,321) and **TREY WHITE** (1,059). RBs **JAKE MCKENZIE** (1,345) and **DARNELL HOLLAND** (1,258) surpassed the milestone in Week 7 at Liberty to give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards.

TORRANCE THE TERRIFIC

Presbyterian College freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** is the first Big South freshman ever to score a touchdown in five consecutive games, as he tallied five (three rushing, two receiving) during Weeks 2-6. Marable is third in the Big South with 852 rushing yards -- just 25 yards off the lead -- and is challenging to become the first Blue Hose player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing.

KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** has caught 60 passes for 627 yards through 10 games. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King has two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 143. Monmouth holds the second-longest active streak at 35 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 32 games.

RANK AND FILE

The Big South returned to the national rankings Oct. 30 following a four-week hiatus, and re-entered the Top 25 with two programs in the FCS Coaches poll. This week, Monmouth is No. 22 in the FCS Coaches Poll while Kennesaw State is at No. 21. It is the fifth time this season two Big South teams were nationally-ranked in the same week, and the 43rd time overall in Big South history. Kennesaw State is at No. 22 in the STATS FCS poll, while the Hawks are in the 26th position of that ranking. The Big South's streak of 83 consecutive weeks with a nationally-ranked football member ended Oct. 2 entering Week 6, which marked the first time the Big South was outside the two major Top 25 polls since Week 8 of the 2011 season (Oct. 17).

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has posted back-to-back seasons with 60+ receptions -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat since Liberty's **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014-15 and the seventh overall in league history. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White now ranks in the league's career Top 10 in receptions (8th - 169), receiving yards (9th - 2,152) and TD catches (T-8th - 20).

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's active career rushing leader with 2,774 -- the only signal-caller in conference annals above the 2,000-yard threshold. That effort is good for seventh all-time in league history and 87 away from moving into sixth-place. Maxwell led the Big South in rushing in 2016 with 965 yards -- the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher -- and is currently fifth this year with 760.

BANK ON BURKS

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** is the second Big South quarterback with 10 rushing touchdowns in a season, as he currently shares the league-lead with 11. The conference single-season record for TD rushes by a signal-caller is 12, set by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. Burks is tied with Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** for first all-time among quarterbacks in Big South history with 20 career rushing scores. Meanwhile, Burks ranks fourth on the Big South's quarterback career rushing list with 1,578 yards, and needs 60 to move into third-place.

GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** has caught 59 passes for a league-best 953 yards and eight TDs in nine games this season. In 11 games as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden has five 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 105.9 receiving yards per game just trails Summers' league record of 108.1. Gandy-Golden is on pace for 1,061 receiving yards, which would be the fifth-highest single-season total in Big South annals.

50-50 RAFFLES

Liberty receiving tandem **DAMIAN KING** (60) and **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** (59) are on the cusp of becoming the first teammates in history to have 60 receptions in the same season. They are already the first pair of Big South teammates with 50 receptions in the same year since 2014 and the seventh overall. It is the third time Liberty has achieved this accomplishment, the most by any school. In Week 1 at Baylor, King and Gandy-Golden became the first Big South teammates ever with at least 10 catches in the same game. Gandy-Golden posted career-highs of 13 receptions for 192 yards against the Bears, while King caught 10 balls for 66 yards.

BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior LB **SOLOMON BROWN** shares the Big South record for most career quarterback sacks by a linebacker with 14.0, a record first set by Coastal Carolina's **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (2003-05). Brown became the 18th member of the league's 30.0 TFL club in Week 8, and sits at 34.0 through 32 career appearances. He needs four solo stops for 100 in his career and 10 total hits for 200.

MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB, Walter Payton Award candidate and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the first Big South QB in league history with 20 career rushing touchdowns and 20 career passing TDs. He broke the quarterback record of 19 rushing TDs with two scores at N.C. Central in Week 7 to give him 20. Maxwell has thrown 24 career scoring strikes. In Week 7, he posted his 10th career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing at N.C. Central to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 165 yards on the ground and 138 through the air against the Eagles. It was Maxwell's 11th career 100-yard rushing game -- the eighth-most by any Big South player.

GOOD-BYES

Liberty University plays its final football game as a Big South member this Saturday, as the Flames are in the midst of its transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision. LU is the league's all-time winningest program in conference action, as the Flames are 55-22 all-time in Big South contests (=71.4 percent). Liberty has scored a point in all 77 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 77 games, the last 65 have been in double digits.

HELLOS

The Big South football membership will feature the addition of Campbell University in 2018, as the school announced on Nov. 14, 2016, that it will begin scholarship football next season, and make the subsequent move to the Big South. Campbell is already a full-time conference member, and is playing its final season of non-scholarship football in the Pioneer Football League. Meanwhile, the University of North Alabama will join Big South Football in 2019 as an associate member, a direct result of the Big South's collaboration agreement with the ASUN Conference in which ASUN members playing scholarship football have an automatic home in the Big South.

ROCK OF AGES

Presbyterian DB **ROCK YA-SIN** is tied for the Big South lead with five interceptions, as well as tied for third with 11 passes defended for a 1.1 per game average. His two fumble recoveries are tied for second-most in the league this season.

TURNING HEADS

Liberty R-junior DB **CHRIS TURNER** has 28 career passes defended (20 PBU and 8 INT). He is two away from becoming the 12th player in Big South history with 30, and has recorded a PD in six of 10 contests this season.

FIRE EMOJI

Liberty amassed 628 yards of offense this past Saturday against Presbyterian, as the Flames racked up 317 rushing yards and 311 passing yards vs. the Blue Hose. It was the fifth time a Big South member posted 300 yards rushing and passing in the same game during the league's football era (since 2002), and Liberty is the first team with two such efforts. LU first recorded the 300 double in 2016 against Monmouth with 331 rushing yards and 350 passing yards.

THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE

Charleston Southern senior DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** forced his third fumble of the season in Week 7 at Presbyterian. He has forced seven fumbles in his career, tied for the third-most in Big South history. That record is nine, set by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**.

HIGH FIVE

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** is the first Big South quarterback in league history with two 5-TD pass games in the same season. He has tied the conference single-game record twice this year -- first in Week 2 and again in Week 8 with five scoring strikes at Monmouth. Calvert, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, now shares the career record of most 5-TD pass games (2) with former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**.

COVER 2

Monmouth R-senior DB **TEDDIE MARTINEZ** is tied for the Big South lead with five interceptions, and posted his second multi-interception game this season with two picks at Bucknell in Week 5. He now has nine career interceptions during his time in the Big South and is one pick shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career INTs.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

CALVERT GETS BIG SOUTH PASSING RECORD TRIFECTA IN BAYLOR WIN

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** set three Big South single-game passing records during the Flames' Week 1 win at Baylor. He established new marks for completions (44), attempts (60) and yardage (447) against the Bears. Calvert's effort bested the previous records of 37 completions (Presbyterian's **TIM WEBB** at Wofford in 2008), 57 attempts (Webb at Appalachian State in 2008) and 430 yards (Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** at VMI in 2014). Calvert's 447 yards of offense at Baylor is the fourth-most in a game in Big South history.
