## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK 4 HONOREES

### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ERIC ZOKOURI, MONMOUTH, RB, Fr (SILVER SPRING, MD.)

Zokouri rushed for 77 yards and two touchdowns on nine second-half carries -- his first rushing attempts of the season -- to lead the Hawks to a 30-23 overtime win at Hampton. His final rush was a 25-yard score on the first overtime play that was the eventual game-winner. With 23 seconds left in the third quarter, Zokouri scored from a yard out to break a 16-16 tie. His first collegiate run was for 14 yards and a first down.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - THOMAS ADAMS, GARDNER-WEBB, SS, R-Sr (MEMPHIS, TENN.)

Adams posted a career-high 14 tackles (10 solo), a half tackle-for-loss and a 53-yard fumble return for a touchdown in the Runnin' Bulldogs' narrow loss at No. 9 Wofford. His defensive score tied the game at 10-10 late in the first half. Adams' effort helped force Wofford's offense into four three-and-out situations.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - BRETT NORTON, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE, P/K, Jr (WALHALLA, S.C.)

Norton made all five of his placekicks for a career-high nine points in helping the Blue Hose to a 27-20 win over Cumberland. He made a career-long 47-yard field goal in the third quarter to tie the game at 20-20 -- his first career make from beyond 40 yards and the longest field goal in PC's Division I era. Norton also landed both of his punts inside the 20-yard line, including his final kick that pinned Cumberland at its own 1-yard line with 1:20 remaining in the game.

### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TORRANCE MARABLE, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE, RB, Fr (DECATUR, GA.)

Marable tallied 193 all-purpose yards and one touchdown in helping Presbyterian to its second win of the season. He rushed for 139 yards on 15 carries, caught an 11-yard touchdown pass and had 32 kickoff return yards. Marable's 25-yard rush in the third quarter set up PC's game-tying field goal, and he later recorded two runs of 10+ yards during the Blue Hose's final scoring drive of the night.

### KENYATTA WILL GET-YA

Gardner-Webb senior LB **KENYATTA DUNBAR** posted his third consecutive game with at least 3.0 TFL this past Saturday at Wofford, and now leads the FCS with 10.0 tackles-for-loss (all solo), and ranks second with 2.5 TFL per game. Dunbar, who entered the season with just 1.5 career stops behind the line, is the first Big South player to record three-straight 3.0+ TFL games since Gardner-Webb All-American DL **HAROLD WELLS** in 2004. Wells posted 10.5 tackles-for-loss during his streak (4.5, 3.0, 3.0).

### TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** leads the Big South and is fourth nationally with six rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist has carried the ball a total of 14 times for 83 yards -- with a long of 42 -- and has scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1 and 3 yards for the Hawks. Jones is looking to become just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season this Saturday.

### TORRANCE THE TERRIFIC

Presbyterian College freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** leads the Big South with 449 rushing yards and 112.2 rushing yards per game. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing yards. Marable is on pace for 1,234 rushing yards this season, which would be the second-most by a Big South freshman in league history behind Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS'** freshman record of 1,310 in 2018.

### STRETCH ARMSTRONG

After three career games, Kennesaw State R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and a two-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1 & 2). Armstrong leads the Big South with 3.0 sacks, 1.33 passes defended per game and two fumble recoveries, is tied for first with two interceptions, is third with 10.3 tackles per game and is tied for sixth with 3.0 TFL.

### BALANCE BEAM

Charleston Southern recorded 620 yards of offense this past Saturday against Point. The Bucs ran for 320 and passed for exactly 300 in the 66-0 victory. It was the program's fourth 600-yard day during its Big South era (since 2002), and the first time the Bucs reached 300 yards rushing and passing in the same game in that timeframe. It was the fourth time in Big South history that a member posted 300 rushing yards and 300 passing yards in a contest.

### RANK AND FILE

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 83 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 40 times overall in league history.

### THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE

Charleston Southern senior DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** forced two fumbles in this past Saturday's victory against Point, and is tied for the league-lead this season. Ellis has now forced six fumbles in his career, tied for the fourth-most in Big South history. That record is nine, set by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**.

### CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT**, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, leads the Big South with 1,392 passing yards and 13 TDs. His 348.0 passing yards per game is pacing way ahead of the league record of 274.7 (Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006), and is on track for a Big South single-season record 3,828 yards. Calvert is also on pace to become the first QB in conference annals to throw 30 touchdown passes in a season, as he is currently on track for 36. He tied the Big South single-game record with five touchdown passes in Week 2.

### MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **MIKE BASILE** is second all-time in Big South history with 224 career solo tackles, and needs 20 to break the career record of 243 solo tackles that is held by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**. Meanwhile, Basile's 349 career total stops are sixth-most in the the Big South record book, and five away from jumping into fifth-place all-time. With his 10.5 tackles per game this season, Basile is on pace to become just the fourth Big South player with 400 career tackles.

## GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** has caught 28 passes for a league-best 499 yards and four TDs in four games this season. In 11 games as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden has three 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 124.8 receiving yards per game is pacing well ahead of Summers' league record of 108.1. Gandy-Golden is on pace for 1,373 receiving yards, which is just under the Big South single-season record of 1,388 by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012.

## THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3 at Alabama State. With exactly 1,000 yards, he is the third player in Kennesaw State's young history to reach the benchmark, behind former teammates **CHASTON BENNETT** (1,321) and **TREY WHITE** (1,059). Meanwhile, KSU RBs **DARNELL HOLLAND** (937) and **JAKE MCKENZIE** (873) are poised to join Burks and give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards.

## BIG BEN

In his last two games -- both wins, Presbyterian College QB **BEN CHEEK** has gone 19-of-27 passing for 290 yards and three touchdowns with a 197.26 pass efficiency rating and zero interceptions. He has also rushed for 74 yards. In Week 3 against future Big South member Campbell, Cheek had touchdown passes of 63 and 70 yards in the Blue Hose's 28-16 victory. He is the first PC signal-caller with two TD passes of at least 60 yards in a game during the Blue Hose's Big South era (since 2008), and the first league quarterback to do so since Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** last season against Kennesaw State.

## KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** has caught a league-high-tying 28 passes for 275 yards through four games. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King already has two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

## HOMEWARD BOUND

Presbyterian College is in the midst of a *SEVEN-GAME* homestand, the longest streak of consecutive home games in Big South history. The Blue Hose will host eight games at Bailey Memorial Stadium this season after the Week 2 PC at The Citadel game was moved to Clinton due to Hurricane Irma. Presbyterian is 2-1 on the current stand, and will remain at home through Saturday, Oct. 21. The Big South's previous longest homestand was four games, which occurred six times and most recently by Gardner-Webb in 2016.

## REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has 130 career receptions for 1,622 receiving yards with 13 TDs. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White is 378 receiving yards shy of becoming the 14th Big South player with 2,000 in a career, and 20 catches away from 150.

## MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB, Walter Payton Award candidate and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's all-time leading rusher among quarterbacks with 2,253 yards -- the only signal-caller above the 2,000-yard threshold. With 16 career rushing scores and 19 career scoring strikes, he is in position to become the first Big South QB with 20 career rushing and passing TDs.

## ELLIS ISLAND

Charleston Southern DL, Buck Buchanan Award candidate and Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **ANTHONY ELLIS** is third in Big South history with 17.5 career sacks and tied for fourth with 38.0 career TFL. He is looking to become just the third player in the conference record book with 40 tackles-for-loss and 20 sacks. He would join Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (53.5 TFL, 20.5 SK) and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** (44.0 TFL, 25.0 SK) in this exclusive club. Ellis is one of two players in Big South history with two 7.0 sack seasons, as well as one of two to lead the conference in tackles-for-loss in consecutive years.

## WEATHERING THE STORM

For the second consecutive year, Charleston Southern has lost a scheduled game due to weather, as the Buccaneers' Week 2 game at South Carolina State was cancelled due to Hurricane Irma. Last season, the Bucs' Week 6 home game against Albany State was cancelled because of Hurricane Matthew. Meanwhile, CSU has replaced the lost SCSU game date with Indiana on Saturday, Oct. 7, which was the Buccaneers' original open date in 2017.

## TURNING HEADS

Liberty R-junior DB **CHRIS TURNER** has 25 career passes defended (17 PBU and 8 INT). He is five away from becoming the 12th player in Big South history with 30. Turner has recorded a PD in three of four contests this season, and in 13 of his last 15 games dating back to last season. Turner is two picks shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career interceptions.

## 2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's active career rushing leader with 2,253 -- good for 16th all-time in league history. He needs 204 yards to enter the Top 10 and 747 rushing yards to become just the sixth player with 3,000 in a career. Maxwell led the Big South in rushing in 2016 with 965 yards -- the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher.

## POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 137. Monmouth holds the second-longest active streak at 29 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 25 games.

## BIG TIME RUSH

Monmouth R-freshman RB **PETE GUERRIERO** set the Big South record for most rushing yards after two games with 328. He bested the previous mark of 321 set by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** in 2006. Guerriero gained 139 and 189 yards, respectively in his first two appearances to become the first Big South freshman with back-to-back 100-yard rushing games since Presbyterian's **LANCE BYRD** in 2009 -- as well as the first to do so to start a season since Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** in 2008.

## UNLIMITED LONG DISTANCE

Kennesaw State junior RB **DARNELL HOLLAND** rushed 84 yards for a touchdown against Tennessee Tech in Week 2, the longest play from scrimmage in KSU's young history and tied for the fourth-longest rush in Big South annals. Also in Week 2, Presbyterian College R-freshman **TORRANCE MARABLE** scampered 76 yards for a score against The Citadel -- the second-longest TD rush ever by a Big South frosh. That record is 83 yards by VMI's **MICHAEL RAINEY-WILES** in 2007.

## TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 television slate features 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3**, **STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**. ESPN3, ESPN's live multi-screen sports network, will exclusively deliver seven games this year, including a "Wildcard" selection the final week of the regular-season. Coverage of that game will be determined 14-21 days in advance. Stadium will televise three exclusive contests, which will all be noon kickoffs. 7Comm/Princeton Media Group is a new television partner in 2017, and will produce and air four football broadcasts on a new regional network of broadcast TV stations named "*College Football Down South*." The first exclusive broadcast date was the Lafayette at Monmouth Week 1 contest on ESPN3, and the package resumes Oct. 14 with the first weekend of Big South games on ESPN3 and Stadium.

## BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

## CALVERT GETS BIG SOUTH PASSING RECORD TRIFECTA IN BAYLOR WIN

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** set three Big South single-game passing records during the Flames' Week 1 win at Baylor. He established new marks for completions (44), attempts (60) and yardage (447) against the Bears. Calvert's effort bested the previous records of 37 completions (Presbyterian's **TIM WEBB** at Wofford in 2008), 57 attempts (Webb at Appalachian State in 2008) and 430 yards (Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** at VMI in 2014). Calvert's 447 yards of offense at Baylor is the fourth-most in a game in Big South history.

## DUMAS DOES MORE

Monmouth R-senior DB **KAMAU DUMAS** recorded four passes defended at Hampton this past Saturday with two interceptions and two pass break-ups. He is the 12th Big South player to have at least four PDs in a game.

## BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior LB **SOLOMON BROWN** has recorded 28.0 TFL and 11.5 sacks in his two-plus seasons in the Big South. He needs 2.5 sacks to equal the conference linebacker sack record of 14.0, which is held by **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (Coastal Carolina, 2003-05), and is 2.0 TFL shy of becoming the 18th player in league annals with 30.

## MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** posted his eighth career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing in Week 3 vs. Western Carolina to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 111 yards on the ground and 139 through the air against the Catamounts. It was Maxwell's ninth career 100-yard rushing game -- tied for the ninth-most by any Big South player.

## "AND I WOULD WALK 500 MILES"

Liberty totaled 500 yards of offense in each of its first three games of the season, just the second time in Big South history that a team opened a campaign with three consecutive 500-yard contests. Gardner-Webb was the first in 2005.

## EN FUENGO

Liberty was the first Big South team in league history to open the season with three consecutive 40-point efforts. The Flames' string during Weeks 1-3 was the longest in the conference since Kennesaw State scored at least 40 points in four straight games last season from Oct. 22-Nov. 12. The Big South record for most consecutive 40-point games is seven.

## SWEET SIXTEEN

Liberty sophomore kicker **ALEX PROBERT** tallied 16 points in each of the first two games this season, becoming the first Big South placekicker with back-to-back 16-point kicking efforts in league history. In Week 1, Probert tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals, as he was a perfect 4-of-4 at Baylor in becoming the 10th different Big South kicker to make four field goals in a contest. Probert has seven career 10-point kicking game, the fourth-most such efforts in the Big South record book.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, KENNESAW STATE TIE FOR TOP PRESEASON SPOT

For the first time, two teams finished as the favorite in the annual Big South preseason football poll, as two-time defending conference champion Charleston Southern University and third-year program Kennesaw State University claimed the top spot in the 2017 preseason rankings as voted by the league's head coaches and media panel. Both teams received nine first-place votes, eight second-place votes and one third-place vote to finish atop the poll with 80 points each. The Owls will host the Buccaneers on Saturday, Nov. 11.

## GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

The Big South Conference was once again represented among the national candidates for the All-state AFCA Good Works Team®, as Kennesaw State's **LUTHER JONES** and Liberty's **TREY TURNER** were among the 146 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

## HELLOS

The Big South football membership will feature the addition of Campbell University in 2018, as the school announced on Nov. 14, 2016, that it will begin scholarship football that season, and make the subsequent move to the Big South. Campbell is already a full-time conference member, and is playing its final season of non-scholarship football in the Pioneer Football League. Meanwhile, the University of North Alabama will join Big South Football in 2019 as an associate member, a direct result of the Big South's collaboration agreement with the ASUN Conference in which ASUN members playing scholarship football have an automatic home in the Big South.

## GOOD-BYES

Liberty University is playing its final football season in the Big South this fall, as the Flames received a waiver from the NCAA to transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision as an independent. With Liberty's transition underway, the Flames are ineligible for the Big South championship and FCS Playoffs, and thus are not eligible for the conference's preseason poll nor the FCS Coaches Top 25 poll. The Flames remain a part of the conference schedule this season and will be considered a league opponent, but will be listed at the bottom of the standings.
