PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK 5 HONOREES

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHANDLER BURKS, KENNESAW STATE, QB, R-Jr (DOUGLASVILLE, GA.)

Burks racked up a game-high 100 rushing yards and two touchdowns, including the go-ahead TD with 16 seconds remaining to propel Kennesaw State past North Greenville, 38-34. He also threw for 111 yards and one score for his third career game with both 100 rushing and passing yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TEDDIE MARTINEZ, MONMOUTH, S, R-Sr (BALTIMORE, Md.)

Martinez accounted for all three of the Hawks' takeaways in Monmouth's 35-13 win at Bucknell. He intercepted two passes -- including one on MU's seven-yard line to end the Bison's potential game-tying drive mid-way through the first quarter. Martinez's second pick was returned into Bucknell territory, and he later recovered a fumble at Monmouth's six-yard line to again keep the Bison off the scoreboard.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TAZ LINDSEY, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, PR, Jr (HEPHZIBAH, GA.)

Lindsey returned a punt 45 yards for a touchdown in Charleston Southern's home victory over Mississippi Valley State. Upon catching the kick, he immediately made one defender miss, avoided another defender and ran down the left sideline to give CSU a 24-7 advantage.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TERRANCE WILSON, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, RB, Fr (LEESVILLE, S.C.)

Wilson rushed for a team-high 106 yards and two touchdowns in CSU's win over Mississippi Valley State. With the Bucs ahead by three at halftime, Wilson opened the second half scoring with a 62-yard touchdown run. He added his second TD early in the fourth quarter on a 44-yard rush.

ROMAN EMPIRE

Kennesaw State R-senior **DB KEON ROMAN** is just the second player in Big South history with at least two interceptions in back-to-back games, as he picked off two passes this past Saturday against North Greenville after collecting two INTs in the team's previous outing at Alabama State in Week 3. Roman joins former Charleston Southern DB **CHARLES JAMES** as the only Big South players to achieve this feat. James' two consecutive multi-INT games occurred in 2010 (five total).

KENYATTA WILL GET-YA

Gardner-Webb senior LB **KENYATTA DUNBAR** leads the FCS with 2.5 TFL per game and is tied for second nationally with 10.0 total tackles-for-loss (all solo). He posted his third consecutive game with at least 3.0 TFL in Week 4 at Wofford -- the first Big South player to record three-straight 3.0+ TFL games since Gardner-Webb All-American DL **HAROLD WELLS** in 2004. Wells posted 10.5 tackles-for-loss during his streak (4.5, 3.0, 3.0). Dunbar entered the season with just 1.5 career stops behind the line.

TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** leads the Big South and is second nationally with seven rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist has carried the ball a total of 25 times for 136 yards -- with a long of 42 -- and has scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1, 3 and 4 yards for the Hawks. Jones is just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season.

STRETCH ARMSTRONG

Kennesaw State R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** leads the Big South with 5.0 sacks -- just two away from tying the league's freshman record of 7.0 set by Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** in 2010 and tied by Charleston Southern LB **SOLOMON BROWN** in 2015. Armstrong, who has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and two-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1 & 2), also ranks in the Big South top five in fumble recoveries (1st), forced fumbles (3rd), tackles per game (4th), TFL (4th) and passes defended (5th).

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **MIKE BASILE** is second all-time in Big South history with 227 career solo tackles, and needs 17 to break the career record of 243 that is held by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**. Meanwhile, Basile's 356 career total stops are fifth-most in the Big South record book, and nine away from jumping into fourth-place all-time. With his 9.8 tackles per game this season, Basile is on pace to become just the fourth Big South player with 400 career tackles. Meanwhile, Basile is tied for second in league history with five career blocked kicks. The all-time record is nine, which is held by Presbyterian College's and three-time NFL Pro Bowler **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

50-50 RAFFLE

For the first time as Big South members, Charleston Southern has scored at least 50 points in back-to-back games. The Buccaneers scored 66 points in Week 4 against Point, followed by 58 points this past Saturday vs. Mississippi Valley State. It was the 11th different time a Big South team posted back-to-back 50-point games.

ALLS WELLS THAT ENDS WELLS

Liberty junior DL **JUWAN WELLS** has posted a TFL in four of five games this season and in 17 of his 26 career appearances (=65.4 percent). He has 24.0 TFLs in his career with 13.0 sacks.

CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT**, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, leads the Big South with 1,611 passing yards and 14 TDs. His 322.2 passing yards per game is pacing way ahead of the league record of 274.7 (Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006), and is on track for a Big South single-season record 3,544 yards. Calvert is also on pace to become the first QB in conference annals to throw 30 touchdown passes in a season, as he is currently on track for 31. He tied the Big South single-game record with five touchdown passes in Week 2. Meanwhile, Calvert is one TD throw away from becoming the 15th Big South player with 30 in a career.

RANK AND FILE

After 83 consecutive weeks with a nationally-ranked football member, the Big South has fallen out of the Top 25 polls for the first time since Week 8 of the 2011 season (Oct. 17). Charleston Southern is the closest member to the Top 25 in this week's rankings, as the Buccaneers are No. 28 in the STATS FCS poll. CSU was also the highest vote-getter among the Big South membership in this week's FCS Coaches poll (No. 36).

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State and Monmouth rank sixth and 11th, respectively, in the nation in rushing defense. The Owls are permitting just 69.0 rushing yards per game and have held three foes to less than 100 yards on the ground. The Hawks have allowed an average of 75.2 rushing yards per game. The Big South single-season record for rushing defense is 101.0 yards per game set by Stony Brook in 2011.

RUSH HOUR

Charleston Southern's defense held Mississippi Valley State to minus-24 yards rushing on 27 attempts this past Saturday, the fewest allowed to a Division I opponent in Big South history and the second-fewest overall in a game. The overall league record is minus-25 yards, set by Gardner-Webb vs. Virginia State in 2011.

TORRANCE THE TERRIFIC

Presbyterian College freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** leads the Big South with 480 rushing yards and 96.0 rushing yards per game. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing yards. Marable is on pace for 1,056 rushing yards this season, which would be the second-most by a Big South freshman in league history behind Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS'** freshman record of 1,310 in 2008.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Charleston Southern has rushed for more than 300 yards in consecutive games for the first time during the Buccaneers' Big South tenure (since 2002). The streak started in Week 4 with 320 against Point and continued this past Saturday with 359 vs. Mississippi Valley State. The last Big South member to post back-to-back games with 300 rushing yards was Kennesaw State last season.

GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** has caught 34 passes for a league-best 549 yards and four TDs in five games this season. In 11 games as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden has three 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 109.8 receiving yards per game is pacing just ahead of Summers' league record of 108.1. Gandy-Golden is on pace for 1,208 receiving yards, which would be the third-highest single-season total in Big South annals.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3 at Alabama State. With 1,100 yards, he is the third player in Kennesaw State's young history to reach the benchmark, behind former teammates **CHASTON BENNETT** (1,321) and **TREY WHITE** (1,059). Meanwhile, KSU RBs **DARNELL HOLLAND** (959) and **JAKE MCKENZIE** (920) are poised to join Burks and give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards. Meanwhile, Burks notched his third career game with 100 yards rushing and passing this past Saturday, which is second-most in Big South history.

KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** has caught a league-high 35 passes for 336 yards through five games. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King already has two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

HOMeward BOUND

Presbyterian College is in the midst of a *SEVEN-GAME* homestand, the longest streak of consecutive home games in Big South history. The Blue Hose will host eight games at Bailey Memorial Stadium this season after the Week 2 PC at The Citadel game was moved to Clinton due to Hurricane Irma. Presbyterian is 2-2 on the current stand, and will remain at home through Saturday, Oct. 21. The Big South's previous longest homestand was four games, which occurred six times and most recently by Gardner-Webb in 2016.

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has 134 career receptions for 1,661 receiving yards with 14 TDs. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White is 339 receiving yards shy of becoming the 14th Big South player with 2,000 in a career, and 16 catches away from 150.

MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB, Walter Payton Award candidate and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's all-time leading rusher among quarterbacks with 2,253 yards -- the only signal-caller above the 2,000-yard threshold. With 16 career rushing scores and 19 career scoring strikes, he is in position to become the first Big South QB with 20 career rushing and passing TDs.

ELLIS ISLAND

Charleston Southern DL, Buck Buchanan Award candidate and Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **ANTHONY ELLIS** is third in Big South history with 18.5 career sacks and 39.5 career TFL. He is looking to become just the third player in the conference record book with 40 tackles-for-loss and 20 sacks. He would join Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (53.5 TFL, 20.5 SK) and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** (44.0 TFL, 25.0 SK) in this exclusive club. Ellis is one of two players in Big South history with two 7.0 sack seasons, as well as one of two to lead the conference in tackles-for-loss in consecutive years.

WEATHERING THE STORM

For the second consecutive year, Charleston Southern lost a scheduled game due to weather, as the Buccaneers' Week 2 game at South Carolina State was cancelled due to Hurricane Irma. Last season, the Bucs' Week 6 home game against Albany State was cancelled because of Hurricane Matthew. Meanwhile, CSU has replaced the lost SCSU game date with Indiana during Week 6 (Oct. 7), which was the Buccaneers' original open date in 2017.

TURNING HEADS

Liberty R-junior DB **CHRIS TURNER** has 26 career passes defended (18 PBU and 8 INT). He is four away from becoming the 12th player in Big South history with 30. Turner has recorded a PD in four of five contests this season, and in 14 of his last 16 games dating back to last season. Turner is two picks shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career interceptions.

TED 2

Monmouth R-senior DB **TEDDIE MARTINEZ** posted his second multi-interception game this season with two picks at Bucknell this past Saturday, and is tied for the league-lead with four. He now has eight career interceptions during his time in the Big South and is two picks shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career INTs. Martinez also owns four fumble recoveries, which is three away from the conference's all-time mark.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's active career rushing leader with 2,253 -- good for 16th all-time in league history. He needs 204 yards to enter the Top 10 and 747 rushing yards to become just the sixth player with 3,000 in a career. Maxwell led the Big South in rushing in 2016 with 965 yards -- the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 138. Monmouth holds the second-longest active streak at 30 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 26 games.

TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 television slate features 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3, STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**. ESPN3, ESPN's live multi-screen sports network, will exclusively deliver seven games this year, including a "Wildcard" selection the final week of the regular-season. Coverage of that game will be determined 14-21 days in advance. Stadium will televise three exclusive contests, which will all be noon kickoffs. 7Comm/Princeton Media Group is a new television partner in 2017, and will produce and air four football broadcasts on a new regional network of broadcast TV stations named "*College Football Down South*." The first exclusive broadcast date was the Lafayette at Monmouth Week 1 contest on ESPN3, and the package resumes Oct. 14 with the first weekend of Big South games on ESPN3 and Stadium.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

KAMERON KAN

Charleston Southern R-sophomore WR **KAMERON BROWN** connected with R-sophomore QB **SHANE BUCENELL** on an 87-yard touchdown pass this past Saturday against Mississippi Valley State, tied for the fourth-longest pass play in Big South history. Brown has caught 36 passes for 760 yards -- a 21.1 career yards per catch average -- and eight scores in just 14 career games.

BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior LB **SOLOMON BROWN** has recorded 28.0 TFL and 11.5 sacks in his two-plus seasons in the Big South. He needs 2.5 sacks to equal the conference linebacker sack record of 14.0, which is held by **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (Coastal Carolina, 2003-05), and is 2.0 TFL shy of becoming the 18th player in league annals with 30.

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** posted his eighth career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing in Week 3 vs. Western Carolina to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 111 yards on the ground and 139 through the air against the Catamounts. It was Maxwell's ninth career 100-yard rushing game -- tied for the ninth-most by any Big South player.

CALVERT GETS BIG SOUTH PASSING RECORD TRIFECTA IN BAYLOR WIN

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** set three Big South single-game passing records during the Flames' Week 1 win at Baylor. He established new marks for completions (44), attempts (60) and yardage (447) against the Bears. Calvert's effort bested the previous records of 37 completions (Presbyterian's **TIM WEBB** at Wofford in 2008), 57 attempts (Webb at Appalachian State in 2008) and 430 yards (Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** at VMI in 2014). Calvert's 447 yards of offense at Baylor is the fourth-most in a game in Big South history.

SWEET SIXTEEN

Liberty sophomore kicker **ALEX PROBERT** tallied 16 points in each of the first two games this season, becoming the first Big South placekicker with back-to-back 16-point kicking efforts in league history. In Week 1, Probert tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals, as he was a perfect 4-of-4 at Baylor in becoming the 10th different Big South kicker to make four field goals in a contest. Probert has seven career 10-point kicking game, the fourth-most such efforts in the Big South record book.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, KENNESAW STATE TIE FOR TOP PRESEASON SPOT

For the first time, two teams finished as the favorite in the annual Big South preseason football poll, as two-time defending conference champion Charleston Southern University and third-year program Kennesaw State University claimed the top spot in the 2017 preseason rankings as voted by the league's head coaches and media panel. Both teams received nine first-place votes, eight second-place votes and one third-place vote to finish atop the poll with 80 points each. The Owls will host the Buccaneers on Saturday, Nov. 11.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

The Big South Conference was once again represented among the national candidates for the All-state AFCA Good Works Team®, as Kennesaw State's **LUTHER JONES** and Liberty's **TREY TURNER** were among the 146 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

HELLOS

The Big South football membership will feature the addition of Campbell University in 2018, as the school announced on Nov. 14, 2016, that it will begin scholarship football that season, and make the subsequent move to the Big South. Campbell is already a full-time conference member, and is playing its final season of non-scholarship football in the Pioneer Football League. Meanwhile, the University of North Alabama will join Big South Football in 2019 as an associate member, a direct result of the Big South's collaboration agreement with the ASUN Conference in which ASUN members playing scholarship football have an automatic home in the Big South.

GOOD-BYES

Liberty University is playing its final football season in the Big South this fall, as the Flames received a waiver from the NCAA to transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision as an independent. With Liberty's transition underway, the Flames are ineligible for the Big South championship and FCS Playoffs, and thus are not eligible for the conference's preseason poll nor the FCS Coaches Top 25 poll. The Flames remain a part of the conference schedule this season and will be considered a league opponent, but will be listed at the bottom of the standings.

* K **TYLER TEKAC** had his school-record consecutive PAT streak end at 43 after his miss in the fourth quarter vs. MVSU.

* **SHANE BUCENELL's** 87-yard touchdown pass to Brown was the third-longest completion in CSU program history, and tied for the fourth-longest in Big South annals.

* **SEKWAN JENKINS' 70-yard** interception return for a touchdown was the Bucs' first pick-six since 2015 when **SOLOMON BROWN** returned an interception 28 yards for a score against Gardner-Webb.

* CSU tied the program single-game record with nine sacks against Mississippi Valley State, which was first established against Presbyterian in 1998.

* RB **TERRANCE WILSON** rushed twice for 106 yards with two scores this past Saturday.

* GWU is looking to avoid its first 0-5 start to the season since 2012 when the Runnin' Bulldogs opened 0-5 that year.

* Eight of the nine FCS teams on GWU's schedule are either ranked in one of two major polls or are receiving votes. GWU's first four games featured two ranked teams, one 2016 bowl squad and a WCU team that has entered the Top 25.

* In Week 4, QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** completed a season-best 20-of-29 passes for 171 yards and two scores -- both in the second half -- of Gardner-Webb's near upset at Wofford.

* Maxwell passed for 147 yards and both scores on 17-of-23 accuracy (73.9%) in the final 30 minutes of action against the Terriers. He connected with 12 different receivers at Wofford, including seven players with at least two catches.

* SS **THOMAS ADAMS** had his best game in a Gardner-Webb uniform at No. 9 Wofford in Week 4, as he finished with a career-high 14 total tackles (10 solo) and giving GWU life late in the first half with a game-tying 53-yard fumble return.

* R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** recorded the Owls' second blocked kick of the season as he swatted away a North Greenville PAT attempt in the second quarter. It was the fourth blocked kick in school history and the first blocked PAT.

* R-freshman RB **SHAQUIL TERRY's** 61-yard rush that set up Kennesaw State's first touchdown was his longest carry as an Owl and the second-longest rush from scrimmage this season.

* Against Wofford this past Saturday, the Blue Hose got a second-quarter touchdown from **TORRANCE MARABLE**, his team-high-tying fourth of the season, for its only score of the game.

* QB **BEN CHEEK** led the offense against the Terriers with a career-high 19 completions for 130 yards, while leading the rushing effort with 11 carries for 44 yards.

* R-freshman DL **KJ PRESLEY** managed 3.5 TFL vs. Wofford, the most by a PC player this year.

* LB **GRANT BEIDEL** has totaled 58 tackles through five games, the fifth-most in FCS this season and tops in the Big South. He led the Blue Hose a year ago with 76 tackles.

* Beidel has back-to-back games with 10+ tackles, after reaching 15 against Cumberland and 12 against Wofford.

* Over the past three games, Cheek has thrown for 420 yards on 38 completions, while also rushing for 118 yards.

* The Blue Hose rank first in the Big South in passing defense, allowing an average of 169.2 passing yards a game.
