PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK 8 HONOREES

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - LONDON JOHNSON, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, QB, R-SOPH (CLIO, S.C.)

Johnson amassed 336 yards of total offense in leading the Buccaneers to a 52-27 win over Savannah State on Saturday. He posted career-highs of 117 rushing yards and 219 passing yards while throwing four touchdown passes. Johnson averaged 9.6 yards per play, was 13-of-19 passing (=68.4 percent) with a 234.72 efficiency rating, and had TD passes of 45, 11, 17 and 29 yards to lead the offense.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - AKEBREN RALLS, KENNESAW STATE, DB, R-JR (FORSYTH, GA.)

Ralls had two touchdown-saving interceptions and another two pass break-ups to help the Kennesaw State defense keep Gardner-Webb out of the end zone in the Owls' 17-3 victory. Just before halftime with GWU threatening to score, Ralls picked-off a pass at the 1-yard line to end the first half. Early in the fourth quarter, he intercepted a pass at the 2-yard line to thwart another Runnin' Bulldog scoring chance.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - PETE GUERRIERO, MONMOUTH, KR, R-Fr (LYNDHURST, N.J.)

Guerriero jump-started Monmouth's scoring in the Hawks' 56-39 win over Liberty. After the Flames went ahead 7-0 less than four minutes into the contest, Guerriero returned the ensuing kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown -- the longest kickoff return in the 25-year of the program -- and tied the game at 7-7. He finished the day with 257 all-purpose yards.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ERIC ZOKOURI, MONMOUTH, RB, Fr (SILVER SPRING, Md.)

Zokouri rushed 18 times for a team-high 193 yards and two scores to help Monmouth win its Big South opener for the first time. His first carry of the day resulted in a 25-yard TD run that put the Hawks ahead for good at 14-7. Zokouri later scored on a 35-yard scamper early in the second quarter to extend Monmouth's lead to 28-13. He had eight rushes for first downs, including a 50-yard run midway through the third quarter that set-up the Hawks' seventh TD of the day.

GOING FOR TWO

Preseason co-favorite Kennesaw State sits atop the Big South standings at 2-0 -- the program's first-ever 2-0 start to the conference season. This week, preseason co-favorite Charleston Southern seeks its third consecutive 2-0 Big South start, while Monmouth is looking to open 2-0 in the Big South for the first time. The last time the Hawks opened a league slate 2-0 was in 2012 as members of the NEC.

RUSH WEEK

Monmouth freshman running back tandem **ERIC ZOKOURI** and **PETE GUERRIERO** combined for 355 rushing yards this past Saturday against Liberty. Zokouri gained a team-high 193 yards with two TDs on 18 carries, while Guerriero tallied 162 and a score on 18 attempts. It was the fourth-highest combined rushing total in a Big South game and the seventh-highest overall total. Zokouri and Guerriero are the first Big South teammates to each rush for more than 150 yards in the same game since Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (182) and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (174) against Charleston Southern on Nov. 5, 2011.

LONDON CALLING

Charleston Southern QB **LONDON JOHNSON** recorded his first career game with 100 rushing and passing yards, as he amassed career highs of 117 rushing yards and 219 passing yards this past Saturday vs. Savannah State. Johnson is the first CSU quarterback to reach the 100 rush / 100 pass plateau in a game since the 2013 season when Bucs' alum and current RBs coach **MALCOLM DIXON** reached the mark in back-to-back games.

WHITEBOARD

Monmouth R-junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** caught 10 passes for 187 yards and two scores this past Saturday vs. Liberty. It was his fifth career 10-reception game, the second-most in Big South history. The career record is eight, held by Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE**.

BIRDS OF A FEATHER

Monmouth racked up 608 yards of offense this past Saturday against Liberty, the ninth-highest total in a Big South game in league history. The Hawks and Flames combined for 95 points, the fourth-highest in a conference match-up, while the combined 1,137 offensive yards were also the fourth-most in a league affair.

BUCS SCORE RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH ROAD WINS

Charleston Southern opened Big South play with a 7-0 win at Presbyterian in Week 7 for its eighth consecutive Big South road win, setting the conference record. The old mark of seven was first accomplished by Liberty from Nov. 18, 2006 to Nov. 14, 2009. CSU's current streak began Nov. 1, 2014.

MONUMENTAL

The 6-1 Monmouth Hawks have scored 30 points in all six victories. The last time the Hawks posted six 30-point games was in 2008 -- which was also the last time MU scored 30 points in six wins. The conference record for most 30-point games in a season is 13 established by Coastal Carolina in 2014.

NIGHT OWLS

Kennesaw State rolled up a conference-game record 498 rushing yards in Week 7 at Liberty, surpassing its old league record of 482 set last season against Monmouth. The Owls have eclipsed 400 rushing yards five times in its existence, and leads the nation in rushing yards per game with 333.0 -- the second-highest single-season average in league history.

ELLIS ISLAND

Charleston Southern DL, Buck Buchanan Award candidate and Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **ANTHONY ELLIS** is just the third player in Big South history with 40 career tackles-for-loss and 20 career sacks. He is tied for second with 20.5 career sacks and is third with 42.0 career TFL and joined Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (53.5 TFL, 20.5 SK) and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** (44.0 TFL, 25.0 SK) in this exclusive club in Week 7. Ellis is second in the Big South this season with 5.5 sacks, and is 1.5 away from joining Uzowihe as the only players in league annals with three 7.0 sack seasons.

IF THE SCHU FITS

Gardner-Webb senior kicker **PAUL SCHUMACHER** became the ninth kicker in Big South history with 30 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 7 at N.C. Central. Schumacher, who is the third GWU kicker on the league's all-time list, sits at 31 and needs three to move into a tie for eighth-place.

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **MIKE BASILE** is the Big South's all-time leader for career solo tackles with 251, as he broke the record of 243 in Week 6 with a Big South single-game record 17 solo hits at Holy Cross. Basile's 382 career total stops are fourth-most in the Big South record book, and 18 away from becoming just the fourth Big South player with 400 career tackles. Meanwhile, Basile is tied for second in league history with five career blocked kicks. The all-time record is nine, which is held by Presbyterian College's and three-time NFL Pro Bowler **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State and Monmouth rank sixth and 12th, respectively, in the nation in rushing defense. The Owls are permitting just 79.6 rushing yards per game and have held four foes to less than 100 yards on the ground -- tied for the fourth-most times in league history. The Hawks have allowed an average of 89.7 rushing yards per game. The Big South single-season record for rushing defense is 101.0 yards per game set by Stony Brook in 2011.

HIGH FIVE

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** is the first Big South quarterback in league history with two 5-TD pass games in the same season. He has tied the conference single-game record twice this year -- first in Week 2 and again this past Saturday with five scoring strikes at Monmouth. Calvert, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, now shares the career record of most 5-TD pass games (2) with former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**.

HOMEWARD BOUND

Presbyterian College concludes its *SEVEN-GAME* homestand this Saturday, the longest streak of consecutive home games in Big South history. The Blue Hose will host eight games at Bailey Memorial Stadium this season after the Week 2 PC at The Citadel game was moved to Clinton due to Hurricane Irma. Presbyterian is 3-3 on the current stand. The Big South's previous longest homestand was four games, which occurred six times and most recently by Gardner-Webb in 2016.

BURKS BREAKS THROUGH

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** has scored a rushing TD in four consecutive games, including three in Week 6 vs. Texas Southern. It was his third career 3-TD rushing game -- tied with former teammate **TREY WHITE** for the most by a Big South quarterback in league history. Burks has 16 career rushing touchdowns, which ranks tied for eighth all-time in league history among quarterbacks, and is sixth with 1,325 career rushing yards. He needs 55 yards to move into fifth-place on the QB career rushing list.

TORRANCE THE TERRIFIC

Presbyterian College freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** is the first Big South freshman ever to score a touchdown in five consecutive games, as he tallied a team-leading five (three rushing, two receiving) during Weeks 2-6. Marable is second in the Big South with 592 rushing yards -- just 20 yards off the lead -- and is looking to become the first Blue Hose player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing.

KENYATTA WILL GET-YA

Gardner-Webb senior LB **KENYATTA DUNBAR** is tied for fifth in the FCS with 1.8 TFL per game and tied for fourth with 12.5 total tackles-for-loss. He posted a TFL in five consecutive games -- including three straight with at least 3.0 TFL during Weeks 2-4 (10.0 total) to be the first Big South player to record three-straight 3.0+ TFL games since Gardner-Webb All-American DL **HAROLD WELLS** in 2004. Wells posted 10.5 tackles-for-loss during his streak (4.5, 3.0, 3.0). Dunbar entered the season with just 1.5 career stops behind the line.

STRETCH ARMSTRONG

Kennesaw State R-freshman LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** leads the Big South with 6.0 sacks -- just one away from tying the league's freshman record of 7.0 set by Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** in 2010 and tied by Charleston Southern LB **SOLOMON BROWN** in 2015. Armstrong, who has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and three-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1, 2 & 6), also ranks among the Big South leaders in fumble recoveries (T-1st), tackles per game (4th), TFL (T-6th), interceptions (T-3rd) and passes defended (T-3rd).

The Big South's exclusive seven-game TV package on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Monmouth at Charleston Southern live from CSU Stadium at 6:00pm. **CHRIS HEMEYER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) have the call from Charleston. ESPN3 is carrying a Big South game each week the remainder of the season, including a "Wildcard" selection the final week of the regular-season. Coverage of that game will be determined 14-21 days in advance.

BIG SOUTH COVERAGE ON STADIUM NETWORK RESUMES SATURDAY

Big South football on the new Stadium Network resumes Saturday with the Liberty at Gardner-Webb contest live at 12:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) have the call from Spangler Stadium. The Big South will appear on Stadium three times this season, which will all be noon kickoffs. The third and final broadcast will be the Nov. 11 Gardner-Webb at Monmouth match-up.

BIG SOUTH DEBUTS ON "COLLEGE FOOTBALL DOWN SOUTH"

A new partnership this season with **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP** features four Big South football broadcasts on a new regional network of broadcast TV stations called "College Football Down South." The first broadcast is Saturday's Kennesaw State at Presbyterian contest. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **JOHN ORCK** (analyst) have the call from Clinton. The next broadcast is the Nov. 4 Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb game.

TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 television slate features 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3**, **STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**.

BIG BEN

Presbyterian College R-junior QB **BEN CHEEK** already has set career-highs in a season for rushing yards (267) and passing TDs (4), and is approaching his personal-best for season passing yards. With 763, he is 74 away from his current-high of 837 set last year. Cheek's 61.2 completion percentage and 122.7 efficiency rating this year are already ahead of his previous highs.

ALLS WELLS THAT ENDS WELLS

Liberty junior DL **JUWAN WELLS** has posted a TFL in five of seven games this season and in 18 of his 28 career appearances (=64.3 percent). He has 24.5 TFLs in his career with 13.0 sacks. Wells ranks first among all Big South defensive lineman with 7.1 tackles per game (sixth overall) and has led the Flames in tackles three times this season.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3. He was the third player in Kennesaw State's young history to reach the benchmark, and is now the program's all-time leader with 1,325 -- ahead of former teammates **CHASTON BENNETT** (1,321) and **TREY WHITE** (1,059). RBs **DARNELL HOLLAND** (1,103) and **JAKE MCKENZIE** (1,166) surpassed the milestone in Week 7 at Liberty to give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards.

CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** leads the Big South with 2,253 passing yards and 21 TDs. His 321.9 passing yards per game is pacing way ahead of the league record of 274.7 (Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006), and is on track for 3,541 yards, which is ahead of the Big South single-season record of 3,389. Calvert could also become the first QB in conference annals to throw 30 touchdown passes in a season, as he is nine away with four games to play. He has tossed a TD pass in nine consecutive games dating back to last season -- the sixth-longest streak in Big South history. Meanwhile, Calvert has two 400-yard passing games to his credit this year -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat in a campaign.

KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** has caught 46 passes for 451 yards through seven games. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King already has two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 140. Monmouth holds the second-longest active streak at 32 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 29 games.

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has 153 career receptions for 1,985 receiving yards with 18 TDs. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White is 15 receiving yards shy of becoming the 14th Big South player with 2,000 in a career. In addition, he is eight catches away from moving in the league's all-time Top 10, as well as two TDs shy of becoming the 10th player with 20.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the Big South's active career rushing leader with 2,626 -- the only signal-caller in conference annals above the 2,000-yard threshold. That effort is good for eighth all-time in league history and six away from moving into seventh-place. He needs 374 rushing yards to become just the sixth player with 3,000 in a career. Maxwell led the Big South in rushing in 2016 with 965 yards -- the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher -- and is currently tops this year with 612.

RANK AND FILE

The Big South's streak of 83 consecutive weeks with a nationally-ranked football member ended Oct. 2 entering Week 6. It was the first time the Big South was outside the two major Top 25 polls since Week 8 of the 2011 season (Oct. 17). This week, Monmouth and Kennesaw State sit on the cusp of the FCS Coaches Top 25, as both squads tied for the 30th position. KSU was the league's highest vote-getter in this week's STATS FCS poll at No. 30 in that ranking.

GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** has caught 47 passes for a league-best 765 yards and seven TDs in seven games this season. In 11 games as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden has four 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 109.3 receiving yards per game is ahead of Summers' league record of 108.1. Gandy-Golden is on pace for 1,202 receiving yards, which would be the third-highest single-season total in Big South annals.

TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** leads the Big South with eight rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist has carried the ball a total of 30 times for 134 yards -- with a long of 42 -- and has scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1, 3, 4 and 4 yards for the Hawks. Jones is just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season.

THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE

Charleston Southern senior DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** forced his third fumble of the season in Week 7 at Presbyterian. He has forced seven fumbles in his career, tied for the third-most in Big South history. That record is nine, set by Coastal Carolina's **QUINN BACKUS**.

ROMAN EMPIRE

Kennesaw State R-senior **DB KEON ROMAN** became just the second player in Big South history with at least two interceptions in back-to-back games when he picked off two passes in Week 5 against North Greenville after collecting two INTs in the team's previous outing at Alabama State in Week 3. Roman joined former Charleston Southern DB **CHARLES JAMES** as the only Big South players to achieve this feat. James' two consecutive multi-INT games occurred in 2010 (five total).

MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB, Walter Payton Award candidate and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **TYRELL MAXWELL** is the first Big South QB in league history with 20 career rushing touchdowns and 20 career passing TDs. He broke the quarterback record of 19 rushing TDs with two scores at N.C. Central in Week 7 to give him 20. Maxwell has thrown 21 career scoring strikes.

TURNING HEADS

Liberty R-junior DB **CHRIS TURNER** has 26 career passes defended (18 PBU and 8 INT). He is four away from becoming the 12th player in Big South history with 30. Turner has recorded a PD in four of seven contests this season, and in 14 of his last 18 games dating back to last season. He is two picks shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career interceptions.

COVER 2

Monmouth R-senior DB **TEDDIE MARTINEZ** posted his second multi-interception game this season with two picks at Bucknell in Week 5, and is tied for the league-lead with four. He now has eight career interceptions during his time in the Big South and is two picks shy of becoming the 11th Big South player with 10 career INTs.

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BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior LB **SOLOMON BROWN** has tied the Big South record for most quarterback sacks by a linebacker, as he now has 14.0 in his career to match the record first set by Coastal Carolina's **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (2003-05). Brown also became the 18th member of the league's 30.0 TFL club this past Saturday, and sits at 32.0 through 29 career appearances.

KAMERON KAN

Charleston Southern R-sophomore WR **KAMERON BROWN** connected with R-sophomore QB **SHANE BUCENELL** on an 87-yard touchdown pass against Mississippi Valley State in Week 5, tied for the fourth-longest pass play in Big South history. In 17 career games, Brown has caught 41 career passes for 850 yards -- a 20.73 career yards per catch average -- and eight scores.

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** posted his 10th career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing in Week 7 at N.C. Central to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 165 yards on the ground and 138 through the air against the Eagles. It was Maxwell's 11th career 100-yard rushing game -- the eighth-most by any Big South player.

DUMAS DOES MORE

Monmouth DB **KAMAU DUMAS** returned a punt 89 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 at Holy Cross -- the second-longest punt return in Big South history. He later intercepted a pass and returned it 39 yards for a score to become the just the second player in the conference record book with a punt return TD and pick-six in the same game. Presbyterian College's **JUSTIN BETHEL** was the first in 2011, when he returned a blocked punt and interception for scores at California on Sept. 17.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, KENNESAW STATE TIE FOR TOP PRESEASON SPOT

For the first time, two teams finished as the favorite in the annual Big South preseason football poll, as two-time defending conference champion Charleston Southern University and third-year program Kennesaw State University claimed the top spot in the 2017 preseason rankings as voted by the league's head coaches and media panel. Both teams received nine first-place votes, eight second-place votes and one third-place vote to finish atop the poll with 80 points each. The Owls will host the Buccaneers on Saturday, Nov. 11.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

CALVERT GETS BIG SOUTH PASSING RECORD TRIFECTA IN BAYLOR WIN

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** set three Big South single-game passing records during the Flames' Week 1 win at Baylor. He established new marks for completions (44), attempts (60) and yardage (447) against the Bears. Calvert's effort bested the previous records of 37 completions (Presbyterian's **TIM WEBB** at Wofford in 2008), 57 attempts (Webb at Appalachian State in 2008) and 430 yards (Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** at VMI in 2014). Calvert's 447 yards of offense at Baylor is the fourth-most in a game in Big South history.

HELLOS

The Big South football membership will feature the addition of Campbell University in 2018, as the school announced on Nov. 14, 2016, that it will begin scholarship football that season, and make the subsequent move to the Big South. Campbell is already a full-time conference member, and is playing its final season of non-scholarship football in the Pioneer Football League. Meanwhile, the University of North Alabama will join Big South Football in 2019 as an associate member, a direct result of the Big South's collaboration agreement with the ASUN Conference in which ASUN members playing scholarship football have an automatic home in the Big South.

GOOD-BYES

Liberty University is playing its final football season in the Big South this fall, as the Flames received a waiver from the NCAA to transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision as an independent. With Liberty's transition underway, the Flames are ineligible for the Big South championship and FCS Playoffs, and thus are not eligible for the conference's preseason poll nor the FCS Coaches Top 25 poll. The Flames remain a part of the conference schedule this season and will be considered a league opponent, but will be listed at the bottom of the standings.
