# Harold Nichols

## Head Coach - Seventh Year

### 2014 Big South Co-Coach of the Year



Nichols completed his sixth season at the helm of the Blue Hose in 2014, ending the season as the Big South Conference Co-Coach of the Year.

Nichols led PC to a 6-5 record, the program's first winning season since 2007 and its first-ever in the Big South. He guided the Blue Hose to ranked wins over No. 12 Furman and No. 22 Charleston Southern and the team's two road wins stand as the most since three in 2007.

Against FCS competition, PC finished with a 5-2 record and its only two losses came to FCS playoff teams Coastal Carolina and Liberty. PC's defense set new school Division I records in nearly every category, including total offense yards (4163), opponent points scored (270), opponent touchdowns (36) and opponent total offense per game (378.5 yards). Those records come in a season that saw the Blue Hose play three FBS teams and against FCS competition, PC

allowed only 15.9 points and 310.0 total offense yards per game.

The Blue Hose also picked up seven Big South weekly awards under Nichols.

On January 14, 2009, Presbyterian College Athletics announced the hiring of Harold Nichols as the head football coach.

Nichols, a 1989 alumnus of PC, came back to the Blue Hose family on January 14, 2009, from Bucknell. Nichols served as the offensive coordinator and assistant since January 2008.

Under Nichols PC finished the 2011 season with its most overall wins since 2008. Its three Big South wins were the most since joining the Conference. The Blue Hose closed out the season with back-to-back wins, its first two-game win streak since 2008.

The Blue Hose went 4-1 at home in 2011 for their most wins at Bailey Memorial Stadium since a 4-2 mark in 2008.

Justin Bethel, who became the Big South all-time leader in blocked kicks, as well as Arizona tackles, was the first person drafted by the NFL under Nichols' watch. He went to the Arizona Cardinals in the sixth round.

In 2010 Nichols led his team to its first Big South win with the 26-24 victory over Gardner Webb and posted an overall record of 2-9. Four players earned honors with Jared Trandon Dendy, Derek Brown, Justin Bethel and Patrick Morgan picking up Big South All-Conference selections. Jared Tavernier was named to the ESPN the Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District team. Several were selected Players-of-the-Week this past season, including Brian Davis, Patrick Morgano, Cam Miller, Jimmy Pruitt and Ryan Singer.

In his first season, Nichols guided PC through its most difficult Division I schedule. Three Blue Hose earned all-conference honors. Defensive standout Justin Bethel, in addition to wideout Patrick McKoy and long snapper Matt Quinn earned second-team accolades.

Under Nichols' watch, newcomers Lance Byrd and Patrick Morgano accounted for four Big South Conference Freshman of the Week honors. One such award for Byrd came on the heels of his school-record 274 rushing yards in his first career start.

In 2008, the Bison racked up 24.6 points per contest in Nichols' lone season with the squad. He helped guide the offense to a season-high 48 points in the season-opening victory over Duquesne, 48-42. In addition to his offensive coordinator duties, Nichols also coached the quarterbacks and running backs. Nichols coached all-conference selection Shawn Pasternak, who totaled a school-record 72 catches for 1,083 yards and 12 touchdowns. His quarterbacks combined to pass for 158-258 (61 percent) and 2,063 yards for 20 touchdowns against just seven interceptions.

Under Nichols, the offense amassed its highest points per game average since 2004, tallying 269 points for the season. The team was just three points shy of eighth place on the program's all-time list. Nichols' spread option attack resulted in Bucknell throwing for more than 2,000 yards for the first time since 2001. In the vaunted running attack, six different student-athletes registered at least 100 yards on the ground, totalling more than 1,600 rushing yards for the season.

Prior to joining Bucknell, Nichols was the associate head coach and offensive coordinator at Rhode Island beginning in April 2000. He also coached the quarterbacks and running backs.

In 2006 Coach Nichols earned the Michael Campbell Top Assistant Coach Award by the All-America Football Foundation.

In 2005, Rhode Island ranked third in the nation in rushing and led the Atlantic 10 with 318.6 yards per game along with 31 touchdowns. It was the second-highest rushing total in school history. In 2000, the Rams rang up a then-school record 2,244 yards on the ground. In 2001 they piled up 2,565 yards for a 233.2 average, third highest in the Atlantic 10 and a new school record. The Rams topped that total by amassing 2,904 yards in 2002.

In 2003, the Rams rambled for 4,005 yards on the ground, second most in the nation, while setting the Atlantic 10 record and yet another school rushing mark. The Rams rushed for 3,074 yards in 2004, second most in school annals. This past season, the Rhode Island finished second in the Atlantic 10 in rushing (192.0) while averaging 308.1 yards of offense.

After graduating from Presbyterian College in 1989 with a degree in political science and a minor in physical education, Nichols began his coaching career on the Blue Hose sideline in 1990. As an assistant coach, he worked with the quarterbacks and running backs while serving dual roles as he was also the director of campus life for the team members.

In July 1992, Nichols started his coaching tenure with Georgia Southern as the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. There, he worked with a variety of student-athletes including wide receivers, running backs, defensive ends, kickers and specialists. His responsibilities included assignment of coaches, being in charge of all visits (official and unofficial), evaluations and all NCAA compliance matters. He helped guide the team to the 1993 Southern Conference title and two Division I-AA playoff berths (1993, 1995).

In each of those years, the team won its first-round game before falling to the eventual national champion (Youngstown State and Montana) and finished 10-3. In five years, Nichols helped the Eagles to a 33-15 mark.

Nichols returned to PC in December of 1996 in the same role his had at Georgia Southern. In his return to PC, Nichols coached the wide receivers, kickers and specialists. He helped head coach Daryl Dickey take the Blue Hose from 5-6 in 1997 to 8-3 and 7-4 the next two seasons before taking the job at Rhode Island.

He and his wife, Dee, have an older daughter, Cassie, and twins, Corey and Cameron.

# 2014 IN REVIEW

Presbyterian College football faces unprecedented Division I expectations in 2015 on the heels its most successful season since the transition, posting a 6-5 record in 2014 with a schedule that included three FBS opponents and three ranked FCS teams.

Harold Nichols earned Big South Co-Coach of the Year honors, leading a group of six Blue Hose that earned League postseason laurels. Donelle Williams and Ed Britt received First Team Big South honors on a defense that smothered opponents and helped PC to new heights.

The season began with a trip to Northern Illinois. The Blue Hose fell but saw numerous bright spots and Jeremiah McKie reach 2,000 all-purpose yards in the effort.

PC returned home to host Bluefield in the program's first home night game since 1990 and the Blue Hose did not disappoint. PC scored a school-record 69 points by way of 523 rushing yards and seven touchdowns, with LaQua Mayes (161 rushing yards, 92 on a TD run) and Demarcus Rouse (117 rushing yards) leading the charge.

The Blue Hose then welcomed 12th-ranked Furman for another night clash. Despite a 107-minute delay due to bad weather, PC held the Paladins to 214 yards and earned its first win over Furman since 1979 with a 10-7 victory. DaRon Dickey earned the Big South Defensive Player of the Week award for his effort, posting six tackles, a forced fumble and a recovery in the historic win.

Punter Stephen Doar earned Big South Special Teams player of the Week for the Furman game, where his eight punts went for an average of 35.6 yards and five landed inside the 20-yard line.

Following a tough loss to NC State, PC traveled back home to host Western Carolina. The Blue Hose returned two interceptions for touchdowns—including the game-winner with 1:46 to go—and the home team pulled out another late-game miracle, 19-14. The entire PC defense was named the Big South Defensive Player of the Week for its role in the victory.

Next came PC's first home loss, a 40-28 setback against No. 3 Coastal Carolina. Despite the loss, PC scored the second-highest point total of the year in the effort.

PC then traveled to Charleston Southern to square off against No. 22 Charleston Southern. Demarcus Rouse scored on the first drive of the game and the defense did the rest, holding the Bucs to three points on three trips to the red zone for the thrilling 7-3 win. The Big South selected Ugonna Akoh as Player of the Week two days later.

Another win followed the next Saturday, a 18-12 Homecoming victory over Monmouth. PC scored late in the fourth quarter and held on for its fifth win of the season, setting a new school Division I record.

Two losses to Liberty and No. 11 Ole Miss pulled PC's record to 5-5, setting up a dramatic season finale at Gardner-Webb to give the Blue Hose their first-ever Division I winning season. In a defensive battle, PC held the Runnin' Bulldogs to 206 yards of offense and only 37 on the ground. Isaiah Lynn posted three sacks, Ed Britt returned a blocked field goal for a touchdown and Darrell Bridges ran for 135 yards and a score to lift PC over Gardner-Webb, 14-7. With Britt's FG return, he became the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns of an interception, fumble and a blocked field goal. All three Blue Hose earned Big South weekly recognition for the win and PC finally earned its first Division I winning record.

Against FCS competition, PC finished with a 5-2 record and its only two losses came to FCS playoff teams Coastal Carolina and Liberty. PC's defense set new school Division I records in nearly every category, including total offense yards (4163), opponent points scored (270), opponent touchdowns (36) and opponent total offense per game (378.5 yards). Those records come in a season that saw the Blue Hose play three FBS teams and against FCS competition, PC allowed only 15.9 points and 310.0 total offense yards per game. The Blue Hose also finished the season with the nation's second-ranked red zone defense.

In addition to Nichols's Coach of the Year honor, linebacker Donelle Williams and junior defensive back Ed Britt earned First Team honors while wide receiver Tobi Antigha, offensive lineman Devinn Ritter and longsnapper Cannon Jordan received Second Team accolades. Defensive end Ugonna Akoh earned a spot on the League All-Academic Team as well.

## Back in the Saddle Again

Presbyterian College football heads into the 2015 season with more momentum than ever before in its Division I history, coming off of a 2014 campaign that saw the Blue Hose go 6-5 overall and finish third in the Big South. This season will come with its share of challenges as well, particularly as the team looks to reload on offense following the departure of several key cogs from last year's squad that went 5-2 in FCS games.

The team returns 53 letterwinners and 16 starters overall, including nine on defense, four on offense and two on special teams. The defense, which ranked second in the Big South, will bring back All-Big South First Teamers Donelle Williams and Ed Britt to lead an impressive group. Other starters include DE Ugonna Akoh, DL Mitchell Anderson, DB Shonquille Byers, LB Daron Dickey, DB Steve Osondu, DE Khari Rosier and DL Derrick Washington. Last season, PC boasted the country's second-ranked red zone defense by limiting opponents to scores just 60 percent of the time out of 35 trips (while forcing seven turnovers).

The offense will turn to experience in the backfield. Redshirt freshman Darrell Bridges impressed late in the season after returning from injury and the running back will join redshirt junior Blake Roberts with Zac Pollard and Quahlin Patterson, who will both make their on-field debuts. Seniors Devron Glenn and Jordan Hallums will lead the receiving corps while Ben Cheek, Kaleb Griffin and Tamyn Garrick will likely compete for the starting quarterback job. Returning starters Austin Allen and Ryan Bristow will anchor the offensive line, with several others boasting playing experience.

On special teams, longtime punting stalwart Stephen Doar (Big South Special Teams Player of the Week on September 15) will return for his final season. Returning starting sophomore Brandon Morrow will lead a stable of placekickers as PC looks to shore up its kicking game.

## Hail to the (Vice) Chief

PC head coach Harold Nichols was named Second Vice President of the American Football Coaches Association this past year. His term will continue as Vice President in 2016 before taking over the Presidency for a one-year term in 2017.

## Poll Position

PC football is predicted to finish fourth in the Big South Conference this season. The team's

fourth-place prediction marks the highest polling result for Presbyterian since fully joining the Big South in 2008.

The Blue Hose, who finished in third place last season with a Division I-era best 6-5 record, garnered 72 points in the annual preseason poll voted on by the league's coaches and a select media panel. The team also received a second-place vote and third-place vote.

## It's An Honor

Blue Hose senior linebacker Donelle Williams and senior defensive back Ed Britt were named to Big South Preseason All-Conference Team.

Williams earns a spot on the Preseason All-Conference team for the second time in his career following a selection in 2012. Britt appears on the team for the first time. Together, they mark PC's eighth and ninth Big South preseason football selections in program history.

Williams, a First Team All-Conference selection in 2015, overtook Justin Bethel for the PC Division I career tackles record last season. He ranked in the Big South in tackles per game (7.4) and led PC with 81 tackles.

Britt also earned a spot on the All-Conference First Team last season. He became the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns of an interception, fumble and a blocked field goal and garnered Big South Special Teams Player of the Week honors on November 17. He finished the season second on the team with 72 tackles.

## Know Thy Enemy

Of PC's 11 opponents in 2015, head coach Harold Nichols and Presbyterian College will face three for the first time in his career: Miami (Ohio), Campbell and Kennesaw State. Last season, Nichols went 3-0 against non-FBS opponents the school played for the first time (Bluefield, Monmouth and Western Carolina).

Kennesaw State joins the Big South Conference as an associate member this season. A full member of the Atlantic Sun, Kennesaw State's football program will compete in the seven-team Big South for four years after officially joining on July 1.

## Night Moves

PC will play two night games in 2015, hosting Campbell on Saturday, September 19 in the home opener before welcoming Chattanooga one week later. PC went 2-0 in night games

last season, scoring a school-record 69 points against Bluefield before upsetting No. 12 Furman a week later, 10-7. The Bluefield game on September 6 marked the program's first night game since 1990.

## Earning Your Stripes

Presbyterian College and adidas begin into a five-year partnership this season in which the Portland, Ore., based company will be the official athletic footwear, apparel and accessory brand of the Blue Hose through the 2019-2020 season.

All uniforms, footwear, apparel and other accessories for PC's football teams—and the school's other 14 varsity sports—will be supplied by adidas beginning with the 2015-16 season.

## Consistency at the Helm

All nine coaches for the Blue Hose in 2015 coached at PC last season as well. Head coach Harold Nichols returns for his seventh season at the helm following his 2014 Big South Co-Coach of the Year award. Tommy Spangler enters his third season as the defensive coordinator, lifting PC to the second-ranked defense in the Big South last season after inheriting a squad that ranked dead last in 2012. Todd Varn also returns for his fifth season as the offensive coordinator after helping PC to six wins in 2014.

## A Winner Is You

PC finished its 2014 home schedule with a 4-2 record at Bailey Memorial Stadium, matching 2011 for the most home wins in a Division I season. The Blue Hose finished the year with six wins, matching a 6-5 campaign in 2007. The team's 3-2 Big South record also matched the 2011 high-water mark when the Blue Hose went 3-3 in the League.

## Across the Nation

In 2014, PC finished the season ranked in the top 30 among FCS schools in red zone defense (2), blocked kicks allowed (9), fewest penalties (17), first downs defense (20), fewest penalty yards (20), time of possession (22) and punt returns (25).

## Rushin' Army

Darrell Bridges and Blake Roberts return to head up a rushing attack that accrued 1,915 yards last season, just 17 yards shy of the Division I record set in 2011. Bridges ranked second on the team last season with 4.7 yards per carry, with Roberts right behind at 4.6.
